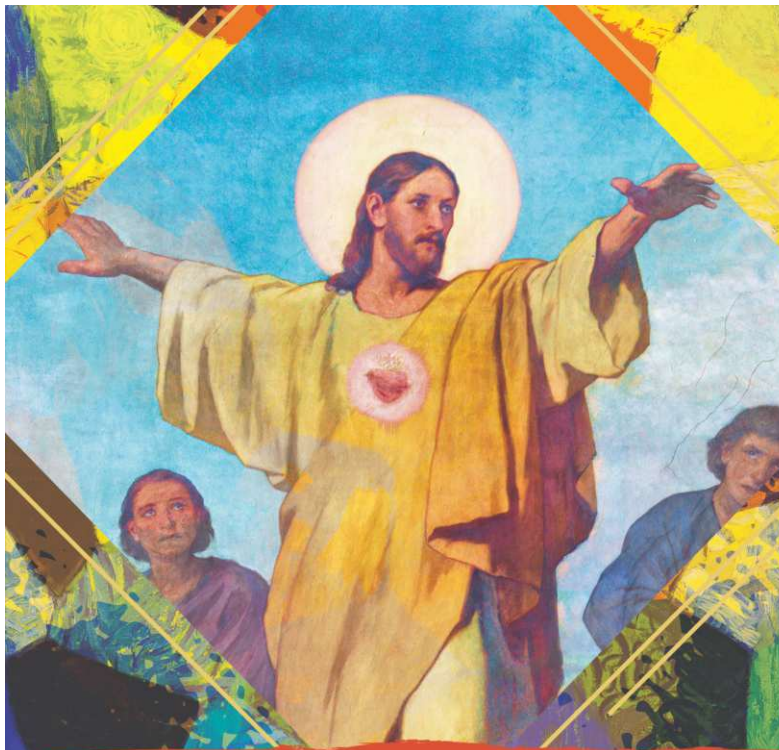

Palabras de nuestro pastor Padre Timothy

EL MISTERIO SAGRADO DEL OFERTORIO: ES MUCHO MÁS QUE TRAER OFRENDAS

Después de la Oración de los Fieles, invitamos a una familia a acercarse al altar llevando el pan y el vino, junto con las oraciones de toda nuestra comunidad. Puede parecer un gesto sencillo, y a veces es fácil que nuestra atención se disperse. Sin embargo, este momento del Ofertorio es uno de los encuentros más sagrados y profundos entre Dios y su pueblo. Algo muy personal y santo está ocurriendo.

1. Enraizado en la Sagrada Escritura

El Ofertorio no es una invención de la Iglesia; nace del corazón mismo de la Escritura. Desde los primeros tiempos, Dios enseñó a su pueblo a ofrecerle el fruto de su trabajo y de su vida.

Abel ofreció los primeros frutos de su rebaño.

Abraham presentó pan y vino por medio de Melquisedec, una clara prefiguración de la Eucaristía.

El pueblo de Israel llevaba ofrendas al Templo como signo de una vida entregada a Dios.

Cada ofrenda expresaba la misma actitud humilde: "Señor, todo viene de Ti, y a Ti lo devolvemos."

Cuando hoy participamos en el Ofertorio, entramos en este ritmo antiguo y sagrado de la fe.

2. El Pan y el Vino Llevan la Historia de Tu Semana

El pan y el vino no son simples objetos; son signos de la vida y del trabajo humano. El pan no cae del cielo. Nace del grano sembrado en la tierra, cosechado, molido, amasado y horneado. El vino, por su parte, requiere poda, esfuerzo, espera y paciencia.

Por eso, cuando el sacerdote los eleva y dice: "Bendito seas, Señor, Dios del universo...", también está presentando ante Dios tu vida entera: tu trabajo y tus responsabilidades, tus alegrías y logros, tu cansancio y tus luchas, tus sacrificios visibles y ocultos, tus oraciones expresadas y silenciosas.

El Ofertorio es el momento en que colocas toda tu semana sobre el altar, incluso aquello que nunca has dicho en voz alta.

3. Tu Sacrificio Unido al de Cristo

En el Calvario, Cristo se ofreció completamente al Padre por amor a nosotros. En cada Misa, ese único sacrificio se hace presente de nuevo. En el Ofertorio, estás invitado a unir tu propia ofrenda a la de Jesús.

Trae tus dolores y preocupaciones. Trae las dificultades de tu matrimonio y de tu familia. Trae tus fracasos, tentaciones y debilidades. Trae tus esperanzas, tu gratitud y tu confianza en la misericordia de Dios.

Por eso el sacerdote ora:

"Oren, hermanos, para que este sacrificio mío y de ustedes sea agradable a Dios, Padre todopoderoso."

Tu sacrificio importa. Tu ofrenda es real. Tu vida es acogida por Dios.

Al venir a Misa cada semana, acerquémonos con un corazón dispuesto a ofrecerse. Cuando el pan y el vino son llevados al altar, colócate allí también, en silencio. Dios recibe lo que le entregas y, a cambio, te da a Cristo mismo.

THE SACRED MYSTERY OF THE OFFERTORY: MORE THAN BRINGING GIFTS

After the Prayer of the Faithful, a family comes forward carrying bread and wine—and with them, the prayers of our parish. It may seem like a simple movement in the Mass, and it can be easy to let our attention drift. Yet this moment, called the Offertory, is one of the most sacred and powerful encounters between God and His people. Something deeply personal is taking place.

1. Rooted in Sacred Scripture

The Offertory is not a ritual invented by the Church; it flows from the heart of Scripture itself. From the beginning, God invited His people to offer back what they had received from Him. Abel offered the firstlings of his flock. Abraham presented bread and wine through Melchizedek—a beautiful foreshadowing of the Eucharist. The people of Israel brought gifts to the Temple as a sign that their lives belonged to God. Each offering said the same humble prayer: “Lord, everything comes from You, and to You we return it.” When we watch the Offertory today, we are stepping into this ancient and holy rhythm of faith.

2. Bread and Wine Carry the Story of Your Week

The bread and wine are not just objects; they are signs of human life and labor. Bread does not simply appear. It begins as grain planted in the earth, harvested, ground, kneaded, and baked. Wine, too, comes through pruning, crushing, waiting, and patience. So when the priest lifts the bread and wine and prays, “Blessed are You, Lord God of all creation...” he is also lifting up your life: your work and responsibilities, your joys and accomplishments, your fatigue and frustrations, your sacrifices seen and unseen, your prayers spoken and unspoken. The Offertory is the moment when your entire week—just as it is—is placed gently on the altar.

3. Your Sacrifice United with Christ’s

At Calvary, Jesus offered Himself completely to the Father out of love for us. At every Mass, that one sacrifice is made present again. During the Offertory, you are invited to place your own life beside His. Bring your struggles and worries. Bring your marriage and family concerns. Bring your failures, temptations, and disappointments. Bring your hopes, your gratitude, and your trust in God’s mercy. This is why the priest prays aloud: “Pray, brothers and sisters, that my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God, the almighty Father.” Your sacrifice matters. Your offering is real. Your life is welcomed by God.

As we come to Mass each week, let us come with hearts ready to be offered. When the bread and wine are carried forward, quietly place yourself there too. God receives what you bring—and in return, He gives you Christ Himself.

St. Blaise | February 3

You may be familiar with the annual “blessing of throats” that many parishes in the United States use to commemorate the beloved bishop and martyr. St.

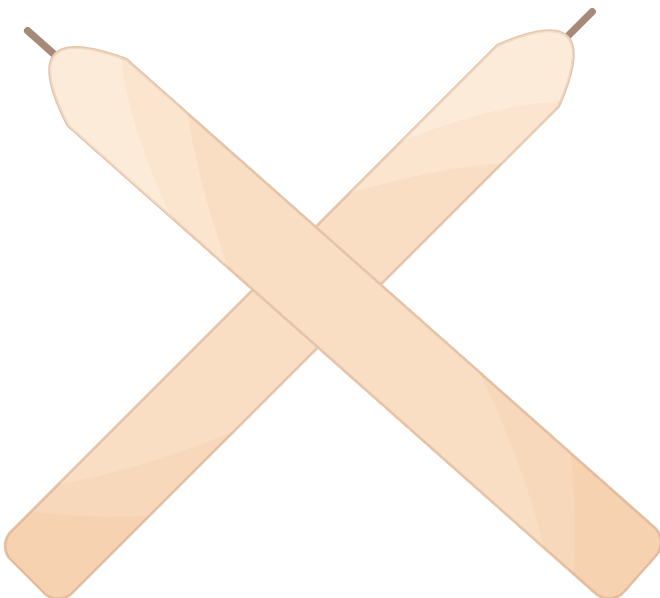
Blaise lived in the fourth century in Turkey and Armenia. Due to religious persecution, he was forced to flee and hide in a cave in the back country in order to save his life.

History has it that one day a group of hunters stumbled upon where St. Blaise was living. They found the bishop kneeling in prayer, surrounded by wolves, lions, and bears that he had tamed. The legend has it that as the hunters dragged Blaise off to prison, a mother came with her young son who had a fish bone lodged in his throat. At Blaise's command, the child was able to cough up the bone and thus lived.

Today we remember the saint on his feast day by taking two candles, crossing them against the throat, and saying the following prayer:

Through the intercession of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from ailments of the throat and from every other evil. In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.


