

STRENGTH AGAINST TEMPTATION

The first Sunday of the season of Lent always includes a Gospel account of the temptation of the Lord Jesus in the desert by the devil. This year, the story is set against the backdrop of the first reading from Genesis, which recounts the very first temptation by the devil. That story is set in a garden of delight. The Gospel story is set in the desert. As believers, we know that temptation comes our way in our own gardens of delight as well as the deserts of our lives. As Lent begins, our attention is drawn to that temptation within each of us to become like God—we want control, power, and answers to all of life’s difficult questions. As communities of faith, we are given this season of repentance so that we can join our hearts with others on the difficult journey of conversion. We look to God and to one another for strength against temptation.



FORTALEZA ANTE LA TENTACIÓN




Pero, ¿y si este año entregas algo REAL? ¿Qué pasa si dejas de creer las mentiras que el enemigo te está susurrando al oído, tratando de separarte más de Dios? ¿Qué pasa si esta Cuaresma dijiste "NO" al enemigo y "SÍ" a la verdad que Dios tiene para ti? ¡No desperdices otro día viviendo enfermo y cansado! Conviértete en una persona diferente en esta Cuaresma y descubre la verdad de Dios para tu vida".

1- Limpia tu alma mediante el sacramento de la confesión y lleva una vida sin manchas, sin impurezas. Un corazón puro y abierto es dócil a escuchar la voz de Dios. Haz un examen de conciencia, arrepíentete de corazón y confíesate.

"Que el Dios de la paz los haga santos en toda su persona. Que se digne guardarlos sin reproche, en su espíritu, su alma y su cuerpo, hasta la venida de Cristo Jesús, nuestro Señor.". 1 Tesalonicenses 5, 232- Pide a Dios la virtud de la humildad, de dejar a un lado la soberbia y el orgullo para recibir las bendiciones de Dios. La humildad es necesaria para ser un verdadero discípulo y actuar conforme sus enseñanzas.

What are the RCIA Scrutinies?

These Rites are celebrated to help deliver the elect from the power sin and Satan, to protect against temptation, and to give them strength in Christ, who is the Way, the Truth, and the Life (RCIA 141). The Rites of Scrutiny are meant to uncover, and then heal, all that is weak, defective, or sinful in the elect's hearts and to bring out through repentance all that is upright, strong and good. Three Scrutinies are celebrated in the parish community on the 3rd, 4th and 5th Sunday's of Lent, after the homily.

The Scripture readings for the Scrutinies ordinarily come Cycle A of the Lectionary: the Gospel story of the Samaritan woman at the well for the 1st Scrutiny, the Gospel story of the healing of the man born blind for the 2nd Scrutiny, and the Gospel story of the raising of Lazarus for the 3rd Scrutiny. The celebrations of the Scrutinies also remind the whole parish community of the need to reflect on their own sins and the need for God's help.

The RCIA invites you to the celebrations of the Scrutinies!

1st. Scrutiny March 15th, 2nd Scrutiny March 22nd. & 3rd Scrutiny March 29th. During the 10 am Mass on Sundays of Lent.

Our Elect in the RCIA have been on a faith journey of study, prayer, and discernment these many months. Part of this process is the celebration of the Scrutinies, a part of the Church's ancient rites of initiation leading to Baptism.

After the homily at each of the Masses there will be special prayers for the Elect meant "to uncover, then heal, all that is weak, defective, and sinful in their hearts" AND especially to "bring out, then strengthen, all that is upright, strong, and good." (RCIA, 141).

The RCIA will then be dismissed as usual and Mass continues.

As brothers and sisters in Christ you are invited to offer your prayers for the Elect at these Masses. God bless you!
