Dear brothers and sisters,

On Mother's Day weekend, our hearts naturally turn to the women who have given us life and love. With God's grace, our mothers welcomed us into this world, and in countless ways—seen and unseen—they helped shape who we are. As we grow older, we begin to see more clearly what their love has meant. We remember their sacrifices, their quiet strength, their guidance, and even their corrections—all given out of love. For many of us, it is hard to imagine our lives without them. They were our first teachers, and often, we learned the most important lessons simply by being held in their arms.

At the same time, we remember that not everyone has had the same experience. Some among us have lost their mothers too soon, or carry the pain of a difficult relationship. Today, we hold you in a special way in our prayers. We trust that God, in His providence, has placed others in your life to offer care, support, and love along the way. Mother's Day can stir many emotions—gratitude, joy, longing, even sorrow. All of these are welcome before the Lord. It is good to bring them to prayer.

This day invites us not only to look back, but also to recognize the power of love in the present—especially the kind of love that builds and sustains family life. It is a moment to give thanks: first to God, the source of all life, and then for our mothers—living and deceased—who said “yes” to God's gift of life and love.

If your mother is still with you, whether near or far, take time to reach out. Tell her you love her. Thank her. If possible, spend time with her, pray with her, and perhaps even come to Mass together. Let her know she is cherished. If your mother has gone home to the Lord, remember her with gratitude. Lift her up in prayer, especially at Mass. Ask God to bless her with eternal joy and peace. Trust that the love you shared continues in Him.

We are reminded of the beautiful words of St. Thérèse of Lisieux:

“The loveliest masterpiece of the heart of God is the heart of a mother.”

May the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of God and our Mother, watch over all mothers, comfort those who grieve, and lead every heart closer to her Son.

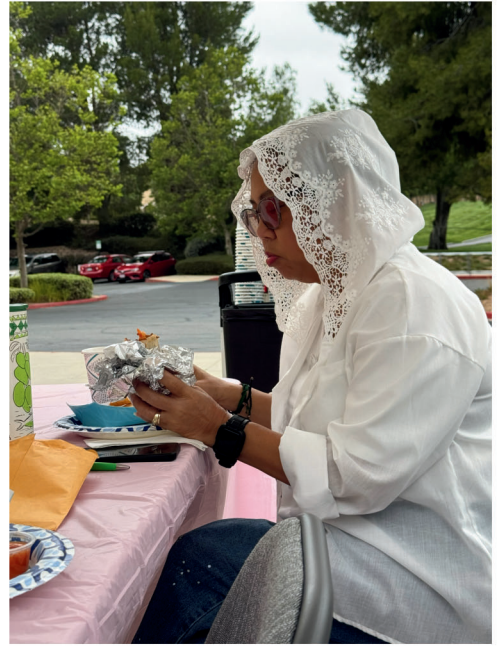
Recordamos las hermosas palabras de Santa Teresita del Niño Jesús:
