WHY DO WE KNEEL IN CHURCH?

There was a time when entering a church meant entering a sacred place with deep awareness. People lowered their voices, made the Sign of the Cross slowly, and bent the knee before the tabernacle with reverence and love. Today, many people rush into church and forget this simple act. Some bow quickly, some walk past the tabernacle without noticing, and some no longer understand why the Church asks us to genuflect at all.

Yet the saints constantly reminded the faithful: “Do not lose this holy gesture.” Why is genuflection so important? Because the body speaks what the heart believes. When we bend our knee before the tabernacle, we proclaim silently but powerfully:

“Jesus, You are truly here.” “You are my Lord and my God.” “I kneel not because I am forced, but because You are worthy of my worship.”

The Church teaches that Jesus Christ is truly present in the Holy Eucharist—Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. The tabernacle is not merely a symbol or decoration within the church building. It is the dwelling place of the living Christ. If people once knelt before earthly kings and rulers, how much more should we kneel before the King of Kings?

The saints often spoke about the spiritual power of this humble gesture. They said that one sincere genuflection shakes the devil because the devil refuses to kneel before God. Every time a Christian bends the knee in adoration, he or she does what Satan would never do: acknowledge God with humility and love.

A true genuflection is more than a habit or a formality. It becomes a small prayer rising silently to Heaven. It humbles pride. It awakens devotion. It reminds both soul and body that Jesus Christ is present among us. In a world that constantly teaches self-centeredness and distraction, kneeling teaches reverence, surrender, and faith.

When you genuflect, you are not simply touching your knee to the floor. You are: making an act of faith, offering a small sacrifice, honoring God with your whole person, and reminding yourself that you stand on holy ground.

This simple gesture also teaches others. Children learn by watching adults. When they see parents and grandparents kneel reverently before the Blessed Sacrament, they begin to understand that the church is not just another building and the Eucharist is not ordinary bread. Reverence is contagious. So is carelessness.

Perhaps one of the greatest losses in modern society is the loss of awe before God. We have become hurried and distracted, even in sacred places. But reverence changes hearts. A church filled with prayerful silence and humble gestures helps souls remember the presence of the Lord.

So the next time you enter a church, do not simply walk past the tabernacle. Pause - Slow down - Bend your knee carefully and prayerfully - Look toward Jesus truly present in the Blessed Sacrament and say quietly in your heart: “My Lord and my God.” If we recover this humble gesture, we will recover reverence. And when reverence returns, hearts begin to remember again that they are standing in the presence of the living God.

PALABRAS DE NUESTRO PASTOR

¿POR QUÉ NOS ARRODILLAMOS EN LA IGLESIA?

Hubo un tiempo en que entrar a una iglesia significaba entrar en un lugar sagrado con profunda conciencia. La gente bajaba la voz, hacía lentamente la Señal de la Cruz y doblaba la rodilla ante el sagrario con reverencia y amor. Hoy, muchas personas entran apresuradamente en la iglesia y olvidan este sencillo acto. Algunos hacen una inclinación rápida, otros pasan de largo frente al sagrario sin siquiera notarlo, y algunos ya no comprenden por qué la Iglesia nos pide hacer la genuflexión.

Sin embargo, los santos repetían constantemente a los fieles: “No pierdan este gesto sagrado.”

¿Por qué es tan importante la genuflexión? Porque el cuerpo expresa lo que el corazón cree. Cuando doblamos la rodilla ante el sagrario, proclamamos silenciosa pero poderosamente: “Jesús, Tú estás verdaderamente aquí.” “Tú eres mi Señor y mi Dios.”

“Me arrodillo no porque estoy obligado, sino porque Tú eres digno de adoración.”

La Iglesia enseña que Jesucristo está verdaderamente presente en la Sagrada Eucaristía: Cuerpo, Sangre, Alma y Divinidad. El sagrario no es solamente un símbolo o un adorno dentro del templo. Es la morada de Cristo vivo. Si antiguamente las personas se arrodillaban ante reyes y gobernantes terrenales, ¿cuánto más debemos arrodillarnos ante el Rey de reyes?

Los santos hablaban frecuentemente del poder espiritual de este humilde gesto. Decían que una sola genuflexión sincera hace temblar al demonio, porque el demonio se niega a doblar la rodilla ante Dios. Cada vez que un cristiano se arrodilla en adoración, hace lo que Satanás jamás hará: reconocer a Dios con humildad y amor.

Una verdadera genuflexión es más que una costumbre o una formalidad. Se convierte en una pequeña oración que asciende silenciosamente al Cielo. Humilla el orgullo. Despierta la devoción. Recuerda al alma y al cuerpo que Jesucristo está presente entre nosotros. En un mundo que constantemente enseña el egoísmo y la distracción, arrodillarse nos enseña reverencia, entrega y fe.

Cuando haces una genuflexión, no simplemente estás tocando el suelo con la rodilla. Estás: haciendo un acto de fe, ofreciendo un pequeño sacrificio, honrando a Dios con toda tu persona, y recordándote a ti mismo que estás sobre tierra santa.

Este sencillo gesto también enseña a los demás. Los niños aprenden observando a los adultos. Cuando ven a sus padres y abuelos arrodillarse reverentemente ante el Santísimo Sacramento, comienzan a comprender que la iglesia no es un edificio cualquiera y que la Eucaristía no es un pan ordinario. La reverencia se contagia. La indiferencia también.

Quizás una de las mayores pérdidas de la sociedad moderna es la pérdida del asombro ante Dios. Nos hemos vuelto apresurados y distraídos, incluso en los lugares sagrados. Pero la reverencia transforma los corazones. Una iglesia llena de silencio orante y de gestos humildes ayuda a las almas a recordar la presencia del Señor.

Por eso, la próxima vez que entres en una iglesia, no pases simplemente frente al sagrario: Détente - Reduce el paso - Dobla la rodilla con calma y oración - Mira a Jesús verdaderamente presente en el Santísimo Sacramento y dile en silencio en tu corazón:

“¡Señor mío y Dios mío!”

Si recuperamos este humilde gesto, recuperaremos también la reverencia. Y cuando la reverencia regresa, los corazones comienzan nuevamente a recordar que están en la presencia del Dios vivo.

We Bear the Name of the Lord

The name of the Lord is a curiously powerful thing. Say it deliberately, even in a group of people who are not particularly religious, and you'll know what I mean. There is a shift in the mood, a change in the atmosphere. When we utter the name of the Lord, He turns His head.

Once, in confession, I admitted to the sin of using the Lord's name in vain. "When you do that, tell God that you love him," advised the priest, who was wise enough to know that I would repeat this sin at some point. "You've said His name, after all. You have His attention."

We hear the name of the Lord, and we think of what it represents — John 3:16, salvation history summed up in a neat little sentence, the why and the how and the who of it all laid out before us. The Lord, so slow to anger that He offers us a million chances. The Lord, so rich in kindness and fidelity that He literally gave Himself to us that we might be saved.

But the name of the Lord is more than that. It is not just a symbol, it is an invitation. I think of Moses clutching the commandments, beseeching the Lord: "Come with us. Forgive us. Receive us as your own." The Lord accompanies us down the mountain. We bear the name of the Lord into the world with us wherever we go.

I have to ask myself: do I do that name justice?

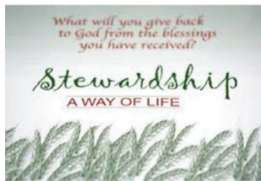

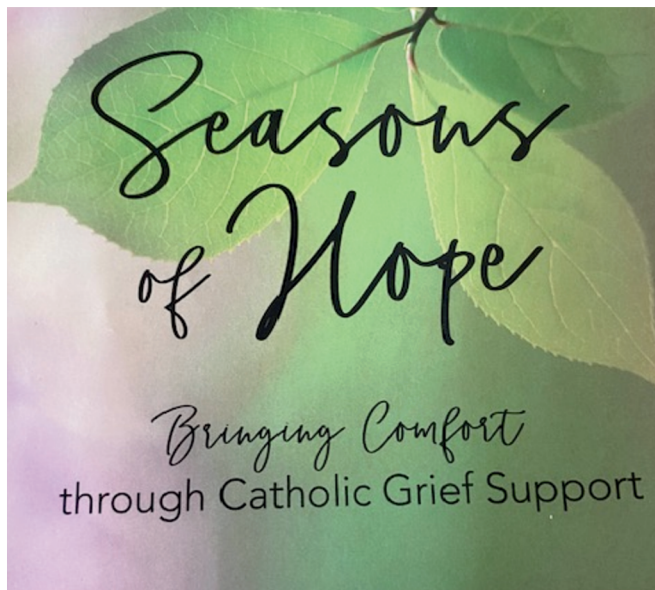


Looking for ways to give back to God?

The Most Holy Trinity
John 3:16-18

I was 16 years old on a youth group retreat in the mountains. One night, I opened my heart to the message being proclaimed: that God so loved the world that He sent His Son for us. Later, I lay under the pine trees and looked up at the countless stars. They seemed different. No longer cold, distant balls of chemical reactions, they appeared as an expression of God's love, as if He were giving those stars directly to me. The truth of God sending His Son changed how I saw the whole universe.

That is what today's Gospel reveals: "God so loved the world that he gave his only Son." (John 3:16) The universe is not just a whirl of impersonal forces or empty space. At its heart is a gift: the Father eternally giving the Son, not to condemn, but to bring life.

This is not abstract doctrine but deeply personal. God gives His Son for you and me. Each human life is precious enough to be caught up in that eternal gift.

It is in the Mass where we encounter this most directly. In the Word proclaimed, in the assembly gathered, in the priest, and above all in the Eucharist, the Father once again gives His Son. What looks like bread and wine is the drama of the Trinity, laboring to love us here and now.

The Trinity is not a puzzle to solve but the blazing Truth at the center of everything: the Father gives the Son for you and me. Lord, help us to see this more clearly.

La Santísima Trinidad
Juan 3:16-18

¡Gloria al Padre, gloria al Hijo y gloria al Espíritu Santo! "¡Así amó Dios al mundo! Le dio al Hijo Único, para que quien cree en él no se pierda, sino que tenga vida eterna" (Juan 3:16). Después de la solemnidad de Pentecostés, que celebramos el domingo pasado, la Iglesia nos invita ahora a celebrar el gran misterio de la Santísima Trinidad: misterio de amor y de unidad.

El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica (número 253) nos habla del dogma de la Santísima Trinidad: La Trinidad es una. No confesamos tres dioses sino un solo Dios en tres personas: "la Trinidad consubstancial". Las personas divinas no se reparten la única divinidad, sino que cada una de ellas es enteramente Dios: "El Padre es lo mismo que es el Hijo, el Hijo lo mismo que es el Padre, el Padre y el Hijo lo mismo que el Espíritu Santo, es decir, un solo Dios por naturaleza". "Cada una de las tres personas es esta realidad, es decir, la substancia, la esencia o la naturaleza divina". Por la gracia del bautismo, "en el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo", somos llamados a participar en la vida de la Bienaventurada Trinidad: aquí abajo, en la oscuridad de la fe, y después de la muerte, en la luz eterna (CIC 265). Dios es amor, y cualquiera de nosotros que haya experimentado lo que es el verdadero amor puede comprender, por la gracia del Espíritu Santo, este gran misterio de fe. La esencia de la Trinidad es servir y amar; por lo tanto, como cristianos, a eso estamos llamados: a servir y amar.

Have you heard of PMFP?

It stands for Parish Ministers' Formation Program. It is an adult faith formation program for all those seeking to learn more about their Catholic faith, especially those who feel called to grow in discipleship and service.

PMFP is a basic level adult faith formation program in which you will learn more about Prayer, Scripture, the meaning of Jesus' life, death, and resurrection in our lives, our role in the Church today and our discipleship.

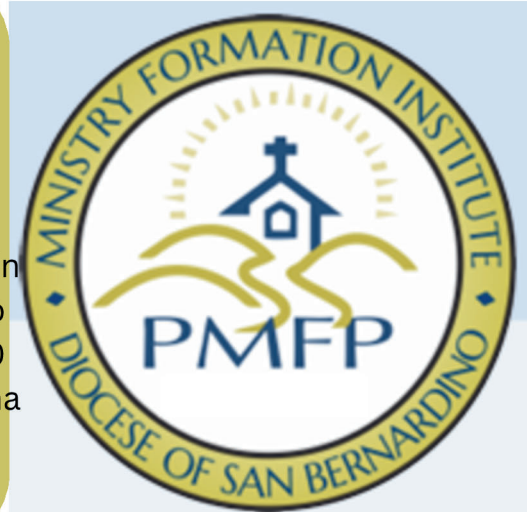
All adults who desire to learn more about their Catholic faith are invited to join us! We especially encourage those serving in parish ministries to register and attend.

The classes meet weekly online. PMFP is offered twice a year beginning in late summer and again in the beginning of the new year. Find upcoming start dates and course information on the MFI website at www.mfisbdiocese.org.

The cost of the program is \$220 per participant, plus the cost of books and materials. After you register, you will receive access to a financial support form.

PMFP - Fall 2026 enrollment is now available. Classes in English will be held online (Zoom) every Tuesday from 6:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. and will start on August 4, 2026. The program concludes on December 15, 2026.

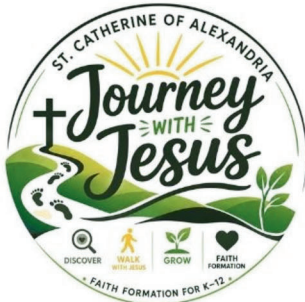

ADULT FAITH FORMATION

We are here to journey with you!

The origin and foundation of Christian Baptism is Jesus. Before starting his public ministry, Jesus submitted himself to the baptism given by John the Baptist. The waters did not purify him; he cleansed the waters. . . . Jesus did not need to be baptized because he was totally faithful to the will of his Father and free from sin. However, he wanted to show his solidarity with human beings in order to reconcile them to the Father. By commanding his disciples to baptize all nations, he established the means by which people would die to sin – original and actual – and begin to live a new life with God.

In Baptism, the Holy Spirit moves us to answer Christ's call to holiness. In Baptism, we are asked to walk by the light of Christ and to trust in his wisdom. We are invited to submit our hearts to Christ with ever deeper love.

Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA)

OCIA brings a non-Catholic who is discerning a call to become a Catholic into full communion with the Church, fully initiated. The process, preparation and formation vary between persons. OCIA is also for non-Catholic Christians who were validly baptized outside of the Catholic Church but desire to become Catholic and receive Confirmation and Eucharist.

Adult Confirmation

Are you a baptized Catholic adult but not yet fully initiated in the Church? Our Adult Confirmation program is for those 18 years of age and older (out of high school) who have been baptized in the Catholic faith but have not yet received the Sacrament of Confirmation. The program also prepares Catholic adults who have also not yet received First Holy Eucharist and/or First Reconciliation.
