## WORDS FROM OUR SHEPHERD FR. TIMOTHY

### ***Why We Should Never Leave Mass Early***

Every Sunday, Catholics gather around the altar to celebrate the greatest gift Jesus left for His Church: the Holy Eucharist. Yet it is not uncommon to see some people quietly leaving right after receiving Holy Communion. Sometimes it may be because of schedules, distractions, or simple habit. But the Mass is not truly finished after Communion. In fact, some of the most beautiful moments are still to come.

There is a story about Judas leaving the Last Supper early. Scripture tells us that after receiving the bread from Jesus, Judas went out into the night. The Gospel of John says, “And it was night” (John 13:30). The early Church Fathers saw deep meaning in those words. Judas was not only leaving the room; he was walking away from the Light of Christ.

By contrast, the other apostles remained with Jesus until the end. They stayed for His prayers, His blessing, and His final words of love.

The Mass is our participation in that same Last Supper and Calvary. At every Eucharist, Jesus gives Himself completely to us – Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. Yet the celebration does not end when we receive Holy Communion. After Communion, we enter into a sacred time of silence, thanksgiving, prayer, and final blessing.

Imagine being invited to dinner by a king. Would we eat quickly and leave before the host speaks his final words? Of course not. We would remain out of respect and gratitude.

So, too, at Mass. After Communion, Jesus is spiritually present within us in a unique and intimate way. The Church encourages us to stay and pray, thanking Him for His love and grace. Then, before we are sent forth, the priest gives the final blessing – not merely a formality, but a mission. We are sent into the world strengthened by Christ to bring His love to others.

The final moments of Mass are important:

The silence after Communion allows us to speak heart-to-heart with Jesus.

The closing prayer gathers all our intentions together.

The final blessing gives us God’s grace for the week ahead.

The dismissal reminds us that we are called to live what we have celebrated.

The word “Mass” comes from the Latin *missa*, meaning “mission.” We do not leave Mass early because the Eucharist is not simply something we attend; it is a relationship we enter into.

Christ gives Himself fully to us, and we are invited to remain fully with Him.

As a parish family, let us renew our reverence for the Holy Mass. Let us remain until the final blessing and dismissal, teaching our children by example that every moment with Jesus matters.

May we never rush away from the Presence of the Lord, but instead remain close to Him with grateful and faithful hearts

## **PALABRAS DE NUESTRO PASTOR PADRE TIMOTHY**

### *Por Qué No Debemos Salir Temprano de la Misa*

Cada domingo, los católicos nos reunimos alrededor del altar para celebrar el regalo más grande que Jesús dejó a su Iglesia: la Sagrada Eucaristía. Sin embargo, no es raro ver a algunas personas salir silenciosamente justo después de recibir la Sagrada Comunión. A veces puede ser por horarios, distracciones o simplemente por costumbre. Pero la Misa no termina realmente después de la Comunión. De hecho, algunos de los momentos más hermosos aún están por venir.

Existe una reflexión sobre Judas saliendo temprano de la Última Cena. La Escritura nos dice que, después de recibir el pan de Jesús, Judas salió. El Evangelio de San Juan dice: “Y era de noche” (Juan 13:30). Los primeros Padres de la Iglesia vieron un profundo significado en esas palabras. Judas no solo estaba dejando el lugar; estaba alejándose de la Luz de Cristo.

En cambio, los otros apóstoles permanecieron con Jesús hasta el final. Se quedaron para escuchar sus oraciones, recibir su bendición y sus últimas palabras de amor.

La Misa es nuestra participación en esa misma Última Cena y en el Calvario. En cada Eucaristía, Jesús se entrega completamente a nosotros — Cuerpo, Sangre, Alma y Divinidad. Sin embargo, la celebración no termina cuando recibimos la Comunión. Después de la Comunión, entramos en un momento sagrado de silencio, acción de gracias, oración y bendición final.

Imaginemos que somos invitados a cenar por un rey. ¿Comeríamos rápidamente y nos iríamos antes de escuchar las últimas palabras del anfitrión? Claro que no. Permaneceríamos por respeto y gratitud.

Así también en la Misa. Después de la Comunión, Jesús está espiritualmente presente dentro de nosotros de una manera única e íntima. La Iglesia nos anima a quedarnos y orar, agradeciéndole por su amor y su gracia. Luego, antes de ser enviados al mundo, el sacerdote nos da la bendición final — no como una simple formalidad, sino como una misión. Somos enviados fortalecidos por Cristo para llevar su amor a los demás.

Los momentos finales de la Misa son importantes:

El silencio después de la Comunión nos permite hablar corazón a corazón con Jesús.

La oración final reúne todas nuestras intenciones.

La bendición final nos concede la gracia de Dios para la semana que comienza.

La despedida nos recuerda que estamos llamados a vivir lo que hemos celebrado.

La palabra “Misa” proviene del latín *missa*, que significa “misión”. No debemos salir temprano porque la Eucaristía no es simplemente algo a lo que asistimos; es una relación en la que entramos. Cristo se entrega totalmente a nosotros, y nosotros estamos invitados a permanecer plenamente con Él.

Como familia parroquial, renovemos nuestra reverencia por la Santa Misa. Permanezcamos hasta la bendición final y despedida y enseñemos a nuestros hijos, con nuestro ejemplo, que cada momento con Jesús es importante.

Que nunca tengamos prisa por alejarnos de la Presencia del Señor, sino que permanezcamos cerca de Él con corazones agradecidos y fieles.

## **Update on the Courtyard Patio Project**

As we continue to prayerfully move forward with the Courtyard Patio Project, we would like to share an update with our parish family. After many thoughtful meetings and conversations with members of the Courtyard Patio Committee and the Works of Mercy Ministry, plans for a beautiful and welcoming patio space between Di Leo Hall and the Sheridan Building are beginning to take shape. We are grateful to be partnering with All Pro Construction as we work together to bring this vision to life for our community.

At this time, All Pro Construction is assisting us with navigating the permit process and the various building requirements established by the City of Temecula. We are thankful for their guidance and expertise as we continue this important step of the project.

The artistic renderings below of the courtyard patio offer a glimpse into what this future gathering space will look like. The plans include an 18' x 57'/41' Alumawood insulated solid patio cover connected to the Sheridan Building (picture 1), as well as a 24' x 32' free-standing Alumawood insulated solid patio cover located in the center of the courtyard (picture 2). Together, these additions will help create a welcoming environment where parishioners, families, and ministries can gather in fellowship, hospitality, and community.

According to All Pro Construction, the total projected cost is \$101,182.50, which includes construction materials, labor, and permit fees.

As we continue this journey together, we humbly ask for your prayers for the success of this project and for all those working to make it possible. We are especially grateful to everyone who has contributed to this year's DDF campaign. Your generosity not only supports the mission and ministries of our Diocese, but also blesses us with the financial support needed for parish improvement projects such as the Courtyard Patio Project and future improvements to our parish campus.

For those who have not yet had the opportunity to participate in this year's DDF campaign, we warmly invite you to prayerfully consider making a contribution. Through your support, we continue building a parish community rooted in faith, fellowship, and service.

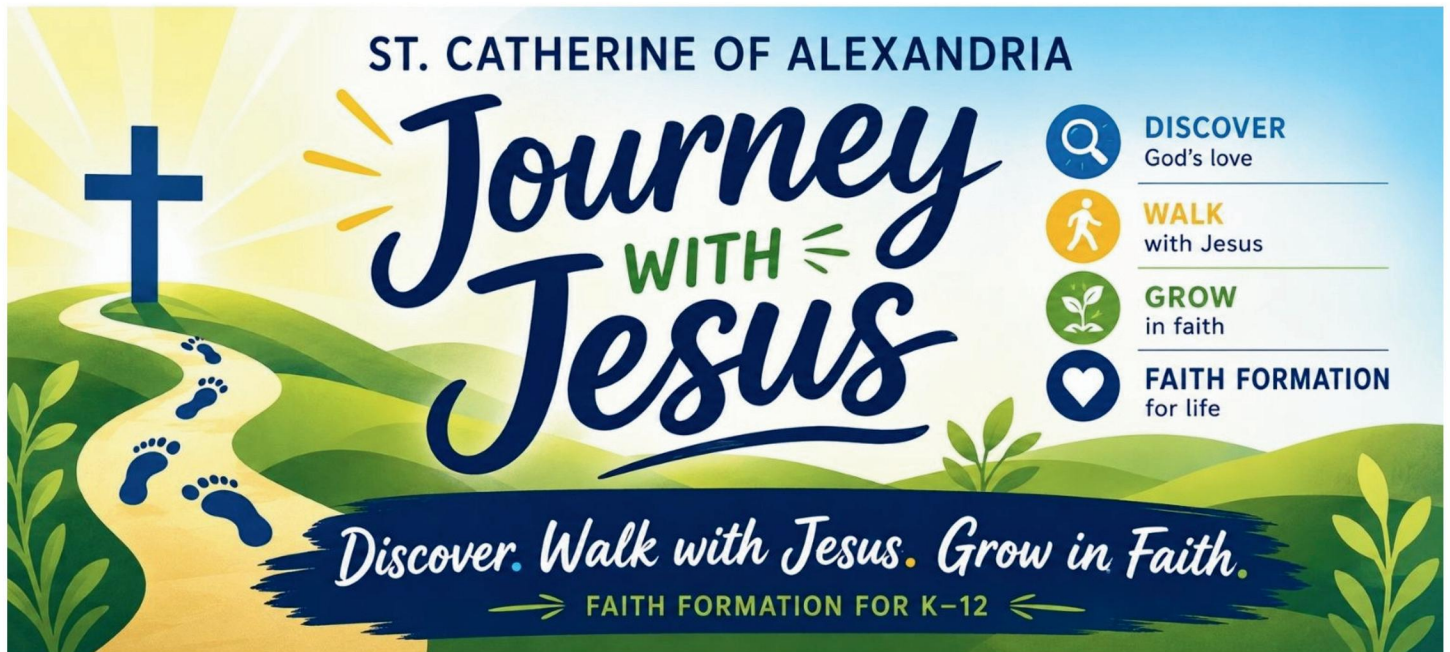

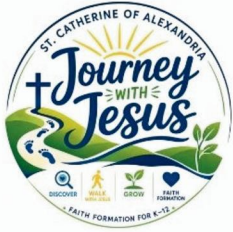

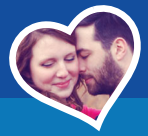
