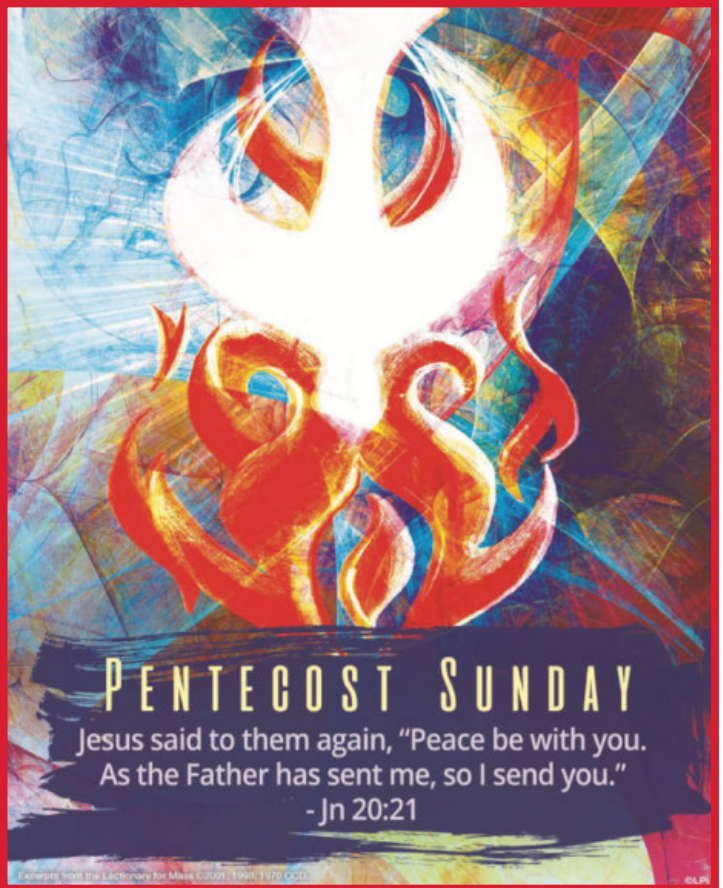

Sustained by this great tradition, and certain that the Jubilee Year will be for the entire Church a lively experience of grace and hope, I hereby decree that the Holy Door of the Basilica of Saint Peter in the Vatican will be opened on 24 December 2024, thus inaugurating the Ordinary Jubilee. On the following Sunday, 29 December 2024, I will open the Holy Door of my cathedral, Saint John Lateran, which on 9 November this year will celebrate the 1700th anniversary of its dedication. Then, on 1 January 2025, the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, the Holy Door of the Papal Basilica of Saint Mary Major will be opened. Finally, Sunday, 5 January 2025, will mark the opening of the Holy Door of the Papal Basilica of Saint Paul Outside the Walls. These last three Holy Doors will be closed on Sunday, 28 December 2025.

El domingo sucesivo, 29 de diciembre de 2024, abriré la Puerta Santa de la Catedral de San Juan de Letrán, que el 9 de noviembre de este año celebrará los 1700 años de su dedicación. A continuación, el 1 de enero de 2025, solemnidad de Santa María, Madre de Dios, se abrirá la Puerta Santa de la Basílica papal de Santa María la Mayor. Y, por último, el domingo 5 de enero se abrirá la Puerta Santa de la Basílica papal de San Pablo extramuros. Estas últimas tres Puertas Santas se cerrarán el domingo 28 de diciembre del mismo año.

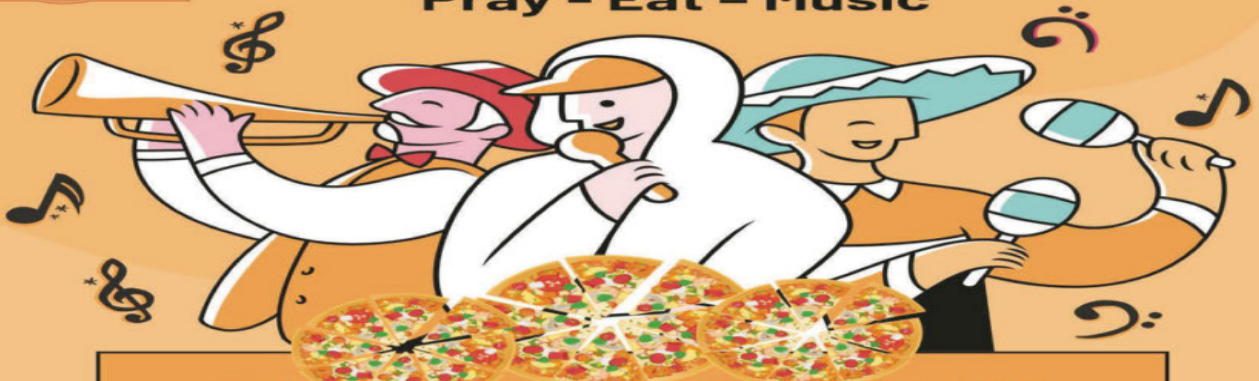

Each year in June a collection is taken to assist the retirement of our local diocesan retired priests. On Father's Day, we will be taking a special collection to continue assisting our Retired Priests in their long-term needs.

Currently we have 29 priests who are retired. All of these priests have served in our parishes. Many are known to you and some still help our parishes by celebrating Masses on the weekends. With the increasing demand for retired priest care, this is our opportunity to reach out to those who within our own Diocese have spent their lives caring for our spiritual and sacramental needs.

The purpose and outcome of this special 2025 Father's Day Appeal will be to assist our diocesan priests in need, and to continue building our Endowment Fund to assist these Diocesan Priests in their long-term needs of ongoing health care, health insurance premiums, auto insurance premiums, housing, and inflationary costs. Your donations also assist our Retirees with emergency medical expenses. Your generosity in this important appeal is greatly appreciated by our Retirees.

Since we started this special collection in 2009, we have been blessed with 41 new priests, and currently we have 20 seminarians preparing for the priesthood. These men will serve for many years in our Diocese. To support these men in their lifetime of service, we must plan carefully for their old age. This requires us to continue building our Priest Relief Endowment Fund to assist Diocesan Priests in their long-term needs.

God bless you for your generosity and commitment and may God continue to bless our Retired Priests for their good and faithful service.

The Procession

During the Last Supper Jesus instituted the Eucharist and he passed it on to us, "Do this in remembrance of me." That is, the Lord handed over to us the celebration of the Eucharist in memory of Him.

It is important for us to have a deeper understanding of the meaning of the Mass. The Mass has two main parts: the Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist. In addition, there are also secondary rites in the Mass.

According to the General Instruction of the Roman Missal, all the rites that precede the Liturgy of the Word: The Entrance Procession, Reverencing the Altar and Greeting the People Gathered, Act of Penance, the Kyrie Eleison, the Gloria, and the Collect are parts of Introductory Rites.

The purpose of these rites is to help the faithful to unite with one another and to prepare their hearts to hear the Word of God seriously and to celebrate Mass worthily.

In some occasions when there is a celebration that precedes and is connected to the Mass, the Introductory Rites are omitted and celebrated in their own way. For example, the procession of palms before the Palm Sunday Mass.

Usually, the procession before Mass, also known as the Entrance Procession, begins at the main entrance of the church and proceeds to the sanctuary. This procession invites the whole community to participate in the Eucharist. Therefore, during the procession, the whole community is invited to sing the Opening Song together.

The procession follows a specific order of liturgical ministers and celebrants. Generally, it starts with the Thurifer (incense bearer), followed by the cross-bearer and candle-bearers, then the deacon with the Book of the Gospels, and finally the priest.

La Procesión

Durante la Última Cena, Jesús instituyó la Eucaristía y nos la entregó con estas palabras: "Hagan esto en memoria mía." Es decir, el Señor nos confió la celebración de la Eucaristía como un memorial de Él.

Es importante que comprendamos más profundamente el significado de la Misa.

La Misa tiene dos partes principales: la Liturgia de la Palabra y la Liturgia de la Eucaristía. Además, hay ritos secundarios dentro de la Misa.

Según la Instrucción General del Misal Romano, todos los ritos que preceden a la Liturgia de la Palabra — la Entrada, el saludo al altar y al pueblo reunido, el Acto Penitencial, el Kyrie eleison, el Gloria y la Oración Colecta— forman parte de los ritos de introducción.

El propósito de estos ritos es ayudar a los fieles a unirse entre sí y a preparar sus corazones para escuchar la Palabra de Dios con seriedad y así celebrar dignamente la Misa.

En algunas ocasiones, cuando hay una celebración que precede y está conectada con la Misa, los ritos de introducción se omiten y se celebran de una manera particular. Por ejemplo, la procesión de los ramos antes de la Misa del Domingo de Ramos.

Normalmente, la procesión antes de la Misa, también conocida como la Procesión de Entrada, comienza en la entrada principal de la iglesia y se dirige hacia el presbiterio. Esta procesión invita a toda la comunidad a participar en la Eucaristía. Por lo tanto, durante la procesión, se invita a toda la comunidad a cantar juntos el Canto de Entrada.

La procesión sigue un orden específico de ministros litúrgicos y celebrantes. Generalmente, comienza con el turiferario (portador del incienso), seguido por el portador de la cruz y los portadores de las velas; luego, el diácono con el Libro de los Evangelios, y finalmente el sacerdote.
