11th Sunday in Ordinary Time
Gospel Meditation

A few years ago, I met a woman in my parish who was a successful lawyer. Yet in her free time, she poured her energy into a nonprofit she founded to advocate for children with special needs. When I asked what inspired her, she spoke of her niece, who was born with disabilities. Her niece was both a glorious gift and a constant challenge. Out of that painful, beautiful experience, she felt called to create something lasting for other children and parents.

The nonprofit thrived, not because she had mapped it all out, but because she was deeply moved to act. In today's Gospel, Jesus is "moved with compassion" for the crowd, for they were "like sheep without a shepherd." (Matthew 9:36) So he calls his disciples, ordinary men with no special qualifications, and sends them to heal, preach, and cast out demons. Their mission flows not from their skills but from his authority and the Spirit's gifts. The Second Vatican Council teaches that the Spirit continually pours out charisms, special graces for the good of the Church and the world (cf. Lumen Gentium 4 & 12). These often arise from the unfolding of our lives: from what breaks your heart, what fills you with hope, what suffering has shaped you. The Spirit works through those very experiences to equip us with gifts that build up others.

What is your charism? Well, what needs around you call you to loving action? This could be where Christ is sending you. Allow your heart to be moved like Christ's. Then get to work.

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

Por lo tanto, urge que colaboremos con Dios de alguna forma: "Rueguen, pues, al dueño de la cosecha que envíe trabajadores a recoger la cosecha" (Mateo 9:38).

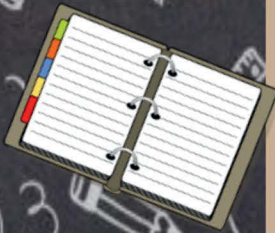

Father's Day Collection for Retired Diocesan Priests June 14th and 21st, 2026

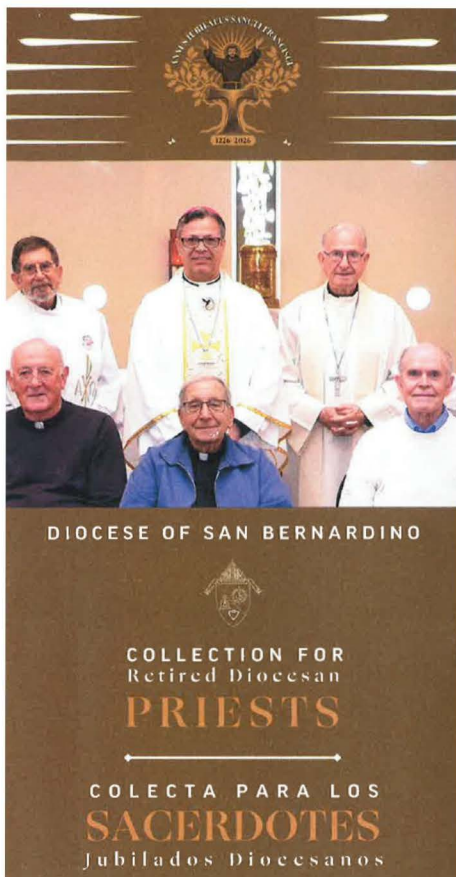
Each year in June a collection is taken to assist the retirement of our local diocesan retired priests. On Father's Day, we will be taking a special collection to continue assisting our Retired Priests in their long-term needs.

Currently we have 26 priests who are retired. All of these priests have served in our parishes. Many are known to you and some still help our parishes by celebrating Masses on the weekends. With the increasing demand for retired priest care, this is our opportunity to reach out to those who within our own Diocese have spent their lives caring for our spiritual and sacramental needs.

The purpose and outcome of this special 2026 Father's Day Appeal will be to assist our diocesan priests in need, and to continue building our Endowment Fund to assist these Diocesan Priests in their long-term needs of ongoing health care, health insurance premiums, auto insurance premiums, housing, and inflationary costs. Your donations also assist our Retirees with emergency medical expenses. Your generosity in this important appeal is greatly appreciated by our Retirees.

Since we started this special collection in 2009, we have been blessed with 43 new priests, and currently we have 25 seminarians preparing for the priesthood. These men will serve for many years in our Diocese. To support these men in their lifetime of service, we must plan carefully for their old age. This requires us to continue building our Priest Relief Endowment Fund to assist Diocesan Priests in their long-term needs.

Colecta del Día del Padre para los sacerdotes diocesanos jubilados 14 y 21 de junio de 2026

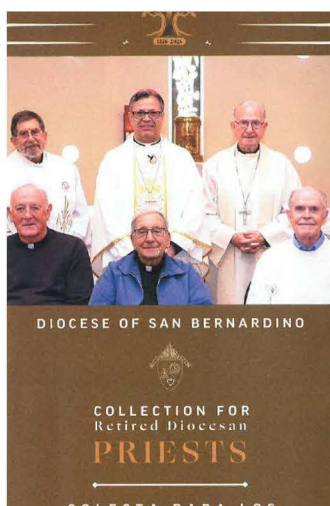

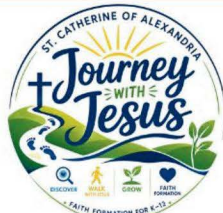

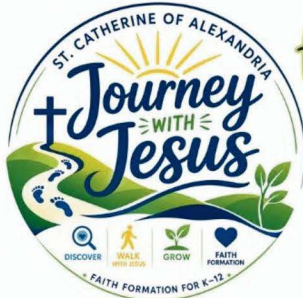
FAITH INTO ACTION CHALLENGE: "SERVE WITH LOVE"

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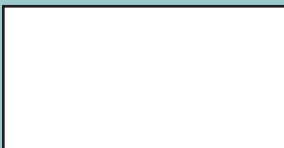

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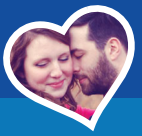
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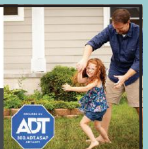
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
