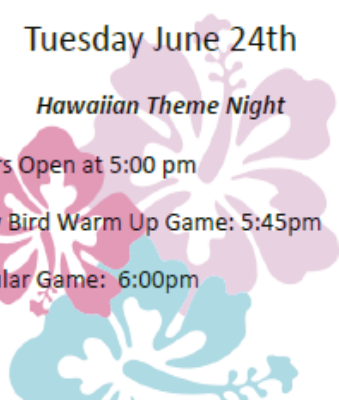

The Opening Song at Mass

When was the entrance ceremony at Mass born? The entrance ceremony with hymn was born in the fifth century, under Pope Celestine I, who was pope from 422 to 432 AD. He decided to sing one of the 150 Psalms at the beginning of the Mass, with the people singing in response. Thus, before Pope Celestine I, there was no opening song when celebrating the Eucharist.

How was the opening hymn sung in the past? In the beginning, the song was sung in the form of alternating responses between two groups/voices of the choir or between the choir and the community. The opening song is usually a Psalm with a preface. The preface is repeated after each verse of the Psalm. This form is similar to the Responsorial Psalm that we are singing after the first reading at Mass today.

What is the meaning of the opening song? When the people have gathered and the priest, the deacons, and ministers are processing toward the altar, the congregation is invited to sing the opening hymn together. This hymn is intended to open the celebration that unites the community, and directs their souls to the mystery of the liturgical season or feast. The hymn also accompanies the procession of priests and ministers to the holy altar.

How is the opening hymn sung now? The hymns must fit the theme of the Mass and have to be approved by the bishops' conference. If there is no cantor or choir, one reader or the priest reads the introductory hymn, which is already written in the Roman Missal for that Mass. If the opening hymn is already sung, reading of the introductory hymn is omitted.

In summary, the meaning of the opening hymn is to bring people together to celebrate the Eucharistic feast, so that the opening hymn is not a song for an individual to sing solo, but it is the hymn for the whole congregation. Therefore, it is necessary for the music director to choose songs that are familiar to the congregation. Also, the opening hymn introduces the theme of the Mass that people are joining to celebrate. The opening hymn helps believers go deeper into the mystery of salvation.



El Canto de Entrada

¿Cuándo nació la ceremonia de entrada? La ceremonia de entrada nació en el siglo V. El Papa Celestino I, quien fue papa del año 422 al 432, decidió cantar 150 salmos al comienzo de la Misa como respuesta. Por lo tanto, antes del Papa Celestino I, no existía un canto de entrada al celebrar la Eucaristía.

¿Cómo se cantaba el himno de entrada en el pasado? Al principio, el canto se realizaba en forma de respuestas alternadas entre dos grupos o voces del coro, o entre el coro y la comunidad. El canto de entrada solía ser un salmo con un estribillo. El estribillo se repetía después de cada verso del salmo. Esta forma es similar al salmo responsorial que cantamos hoy después de la primera lectura en la Misa.

¿Cuál es el significado del canto de entrada? Cuando el pueblo se ha reunido y el sacerdote, los diáconos y ministros se dirigen en procesión hacia el altar, se invita a la asamblea a cantar juntos el himno de entrada. Este himno tiene como propósito abrir la celebración, unir a la comunidad y dirigir sus almas hacia el misterio del tiempo litúrgico o la fiesta que se celebra. El himno también acompaña la procesión de los sacerdotes y ministros hasta el altar sagrado.

¿Cómo se canta actualmente el himno de entrada? Los himnos deben adecuarse al tema de la Misa y contar con la aprobación de la conferencia episcopal. Si no hay un cantor o coro, un lector o el sacerdote puede leer el himno introductorio que ya está escrito en el Misal Romano. Si ya se canta el himno de entrada, el himno introductorio se omite.

En resumen, el significado del himno de entrada es reunir al pueblo para celebrar la fiesta eucarística. Por eso, no es un canto para ser interpretado en solitario, sino un himno para toda la congregación. Por lo tanto, es necesario que el director musical elija cantos que sean familiares para la comunidad. Además, el himno de entrada introduce el tema de la Misa que se va a celebrar y ayuda a los creyentes a profundizar en el misterio de la salvación.

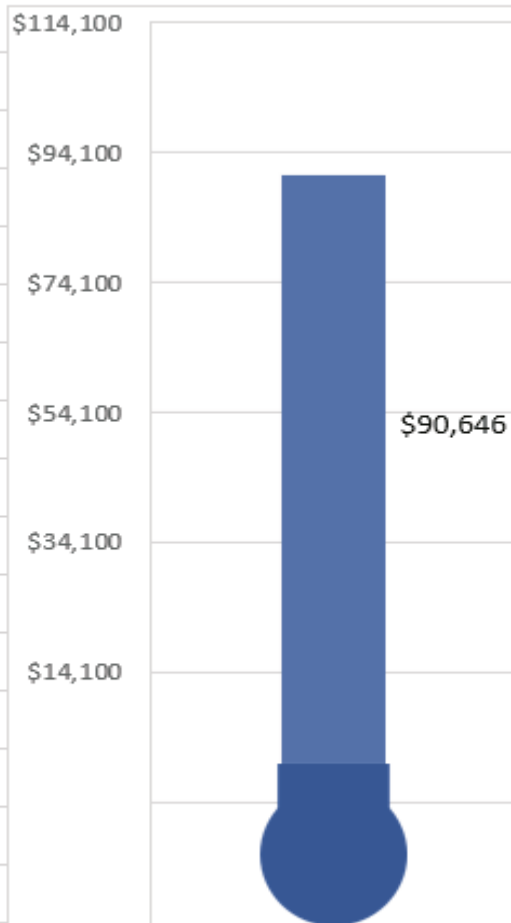

I further decree that on Sunday, 29 December 2024, in every cathedral and co-cathedral, diocesan bishops are to celebrate Holy Mass as the solemn opening of the Jubilee Year, using the ritual indications that will be provided for that occasion. For celebrations in co-cathedrals, the bishop's place can be taken by a suitably designated delegate. A pilgrimage that sets out from a church chosen for the collectio and then proceeds to the cathedral can serve to symbolize the journey of hope that, illumined by the word of God, unites all the faithful. In the course of this pilgrimage, passages from the present Document can be read, along with the announcement of the Jubilee Indulgence to be gained in accordance with the prescriptions found in the ritual indications mentioned above. The Holy Year will conclude in the particular Churches on Sunday, 28 December 2025; in the course of the year, every effort should be made to enable the People of God to participate fully in its proclamation of hope in God's grace and in the signs that attest to its efficacy.

The Ordinary Jubilee will conclude with the closing of the Holy Door in the Papal Basilica of Saint Peter in the Vatican on 6 January 2026, the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord. During the Holy Year, may the light of Christian hope illumine every man and woman, as a message of God's love addressed to all! And may the Church bear faithful witness to this message in every part of the world!

Y que la Iglesia sea testigo fiel de este anuncio en todas partes del mundo.
