WORDS FROM OUR SHEPHERD

FR. TIMOTHY

Why Do Catholics Stand, Sit, and Kneel at Mass?

If you've been coming to Mass for years, you probably move almost automatically: stand, sit, kneel. But have you ever stopped to ask why? These postures are much more than routine movements. They are ways that we pray with our whole person-body, mind, and soul. The Church teaches that our outward actions express the faith that is in our hearts.

We Stand: A People Ready to Respond

Standing is the posture of reverence, attentiveness, and hope. Throughout Scripture, people stand in the presence of someone worthy of honor. As baptized Christians, we also stand as a people who share in Christ's Resurrection and are ready to hear and respond to His call.

We normally stand: At the beginning and conclusion of Mass. For the proclamation of the Gospel. During the Profession of Faith (Creed). For the Prayer of the Faithful. During the Lord's Prayer. When we stand, our bodies are saying: "Speak, Lord; your servant is listening." (1 Samuel 3:10)

We Sit: A People Who Listen and Learn

Sitting is the posture of a disciple. The Gospels often portray Jesus teaching His followers, and His disciples gathered to listen. At Mass, we sit to receive God's Word with attentive hearts and to reflect on what we have heard.

We normally sit: During the First and Second Readings. For the Responsorial Psalm (in many places). During the Homily. During the Preparation of the Gifts. Our posture reminds us: "Lord, teach me. Open my heart to Your Word."

Before we are sent into the world, we first allow God to teach and form us.

We Kneel: A People Who Adore

Kneeling is one of the Church's deepest expressions of humility and worship.

During the Eucharistic Prayer, we kneel because Christ becomes truly present - Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity - in the Holy Eucharist. We kneel in awe before the mystery of God's saving love.

Kneeling expresses: Adoration. Humility. Reverence. Complete surrender to God. Our bodies proclaim what our hearts believe: "My Lord and my God!" (John 20:28)

In the United States, we normally kneel during the Eucharistic Prayer, from after the Holy, Holy, Holy until after the Great Amen, except when prevented by health, lack of space, or another good reason.

Praying with Our Whole Being

The Mass is not simply something we watch; it is an encounter in which we participate with our whole selves. Every posture helps us enter more deeply into the sacred mysteries: Standing reminds us to honor God and respond to His call. Sitting reminds us to receive His Word as faithful disciples. Kneeling reminds us to adore Christ truly present among us. When we understand the meaning behind these simple gestures, they become more than habits - they become acts of faith.

May every time we stand, sit, and kneel at Mass draw us closer to Jesus Christ, so that our bodies and our hearts may together proclaim His glory.

PALABRAS DE NUESTRO PASTOR

PADRE TIMOTHY

¿Por qué los católicos nos ponemos de pie, nos sentamos y nos arrodillamos durante la Santa Misa? Si usted ha asistido a Misa durante muchos años, probablemente realiza estos movimientos casi de manera automática: nos ponemos de pie, nos sentamos y nos arrodillamos. Pero, ¿alguna vez se ha preguntado por qué lo hacemos? Estas posturas son mucho más que simples movimientos. Son una manera de orar con todo nuestro ser: cuerpo, mente y alma. La Iglesia nos enseña que nuestros gestos exteriores expresan la fe que llevamos en el corazón.

Nos ponemos de pie: Un pueblo dispuesto a responder

Estar de pie es la postura del respeto, la atención y la esperanza.

A lo largo de la Sagrada Escritura, las personas permanecían de pie en presencia de alguien digno de honor. Como cristianos bautizados, también permanecemos de pie porque compartimos la vida nueva de la Resurrección de Cristo y estamos dispuestos a escuchar y responder a su llamado.

Normalmente nos ponemos de pie: Al inicio y al final de la Misa. Durante la proclamación del Evangelio. Durante el Credo o Profesión de Fe. En la Oración de los Fieles. Durante el Padre Nuestro. Al ponernos de pie, nuestro cuerpo dice: «Habla, Señor, que tu siervo escucha.» (1 Samuel 3, 10)

Nos sentamos: Un pueblo que escucha y aprende

Sentarse es la postura del discípulo. Los Evangelios presentan con frecuencia a Jesús enseñando a sus discípulos. En la Misa, nos sentamos para recibir la Palabra de Dios con un corazón atento y para meditar lo que hemos escuchado.

Normalmente nos sentamos: Durante la Primera y la Segunda Lectura. Durante el Salmo Responsorial (en muchos lugares). Durante la Homilía. Durante la Preparación de las Ofrendas. Nuestra postura expresa esta oración: «Señor, enséñame. Abre mi corazón a tu Palabra.» Antes de ser enviados al mundo, primero permitimos que Dios nos forme y nos instruya.

Nos arrodillamos: Un pueblo que adora

Arrodillarse es una de las expresiones más profundas de humildad y adoración en la Iglesia. Durante la Plegaria Eucarística nos arrodillamos porque Cristo se hace verdaderamente presente -con su Cuerpo, Sangre, Alma y Divinidad- en la Sagrada Eucaristía. Nos arrodillamos con asombro ante el misterio del amor salvador de Dios.

Arrodillarnos expresa: Adoración. Humildad. Reverencia. Entrega total a Dios. Nuestro cuerpo proclama lo que cree nuestro corazón: «¡Señor mío y Dios mío!» (Juan 20, 28)

En los Estados Unidos, normalmente permanecemos arrodillados durante la Plegaria Eucarística, desde después del Santo, Santo, Santo hasta después del Gran Amén, salvo por motivos de salud, falta de espacio u otra razón justa. En otros países pueden existir diferentes normas litúrgicas, pero el significado es el mismo: la humilde adoración a Cristo realmente presente.

Oramos con todo nuestro ser

La Misa no es simplemente algo que observamos; es un encuentro en el que participamos con todo nuestro ser. Cada postura nos ayuda a entrar más profundamente en los santos misterios: De pie, honramos a Dios y respondemos a su llamado. Sentados, recibimos su Palabra como verdaderos discípulos. Arrodillados, adoramos a Cristo realmente presente entre nosotros. Cuando comprendemos el significado de estos sencillos gestos, dejan de ser una costumbre y se convierten en auténticos actos de fe.

Que cada vez que nos pongamos de pie, nos sentemos y nos arrodillemos durante la Santa Misa, nuestro cuerpo y nuestro corazón glorifiquen a Jesucristo y nos acerquen cada vez más a Él.
