The Power of Mass Intentions

The Catholic Church teaches that the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is the highest act of worship and the most powerful prayer on earth. At every Mass, the one sacrifice of Jesus Christ on Calvary is made sacramentally present, and the faithful are invited to unite their prayers with His perfect offering to the Father.

One beautiful way Catholics participate in this mystery is by requesting a Mass intention. Through a Mass intention, we entrust a particular person or need to God through the Holy Eucharist. It is one of the greatest spiritual gifts we can offer for both the living and the dead.

What Is a Mass Intention?

A Mass intention is a specific prayer request for which a priest celebrates the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. A Mass may be offered: For a living person, asking God to grant healing, strength, guidance, or abundant blessings. For a deceased person, praying for the repose of his or her soul. In thanksgiving for blessings and favors already received. For special intentions such as peace, conversion, vocations, family needs, protection, or any personal petition.

By requesting a Mass intention, we unite our prayers to Christ's eternal sacrifice—the greatest prayer the Church can offer.

Mass Intentions for the Living

The Holy Mass obtains countless spiritual graces for those who are living. A Mass may be offered: For healing of body, mind, and soul. For strength during suffering and life's trials. For God's guidance in important decisions. For peace, unity, and protection within families. For birthdays, anniversaries, weddings, ordinations, and other significant occasions. For conversion, holiness, and perseverance in the Christian life.

Every Mass places our intentions before God in the most perfect act of worship and entrusts them to His loving providence.

Mass Intentions for the Dead

Offering the Holy Mass for the faithful departed is one of the greatest acts of charity a Catholic can perform. From the earliest days of the Church, Christians have prayed for the dead and commended them to God's mercy. The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass:

Assists the souls in Purgatory through the infinite merits of Christ. Expresses our enduring love and remembrance for those who have gone before us in faith. Becomes a powerful plea for God's mercy and eternal rest. Reflects our hope in the Resurrection and the promise of everlasting life.

No prayer benefits the faithful departed more than the Holy Mass.

Why Is the Mass So Powerful?

The Mass is far more than a prayer service or religious gathering. It is: The sacramental re-presentation of Christ's one sacrifice on Calvary. The perfect offering of Jesus Christ, who is both Priest and Victim. The source from which abundant graces flow to the Church and the world. The highest act of worship that gives perfect glory to God. Because the Mass is Christ's own sacrifice offered to the Father, no prayer on earth is greater or more pleasing to God.

A Gift Beyond Measure

Having a Mass offered for a loved one, a deceased family member, or a special intention is a profound expression of faith, hope, and charity. Through the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, we confidently place our needs before God, trusting in His mercy, wisdom, and divine providence. The greatest gift we can offer another person is not merely our prayers, but Christ Himself—truly present in the Holy Eucharist and offered upon the altar for the salvation of the world.

As Saint Padre Pio beautifully reminded us: "It would be easier for the world to survive without the sun than to do without the Holy Mass."

El Poder de las Intenciones de Misa

La Iglesia Católica enseña que el Santo Sacrificio de la Misa es el acto supremo de adoración y la oración más poderosa sobre la tierra. En cada Misa, el único sacrificio de Jesucristo en el Calvario se hace sacramentalmente presente, y los fieles están invitados a unir sus oraciones a su ofrenda perfecta al Padre.

Una hermosa manera en que los católicos participan en este misterio es solicitando una intención de Misa. Por medio de una intención de Misa, confiamos a una persona o necesidad particular a Dios a través de la Sagrada Eucaristía. Es uno de los mayores regalos espirituales que podemos ofrecer tanto por los vivos como por los difuntos.

¿Qué es una intención de Misa?

Una intención de Misa es una petición específica de oración por la cual un sacerdote celebra el Santo Sacrificio de la Misa. Una Misa puede ofrecerse: Por una persona viva, pidiendo a Dios sanación, fortaleza, guía o abundantes bendiciones. Por una persona fallecida, rogando por el eterno descanso de su alma. En acción de gracias por bendiciones y favores recibidos. Por intenciones especiales como la paz, la conversión, las vocaciones, las necesidades familiares, la protección o cualquier petición personal.

Al solicitar una intención de Misa, unimos nuestras oraciones al sacrificio eterno de Cristo, la oración más grande que la Iglesia puede ofrecer.

Intenciones de Misa por los vivos

La Santa Misa obtiene innumerables gracias espirituales para quienes aún viven. Una Misa puede ofrecerse: Por la sanación del cuerpo, la mente y el alma. Por fortaleza durante el sufrimiento y las pruebas de la vida. Por la guía de Dios en decisiones importantes. Por la paz, la unidad y la protección de las familias. Por cumpleaños, aniversarios, bodas, ordenaciones y otras ocasiones significativas. Por la conversión, la santidad y la perseverancia en la vida cristiana. Cada Misa presenta nuestras intenciones ante Dios en el acto más perfecto de adoración y las confía a su amorosa providencia.

Intenciones de Misa por los difuntos

Ofrecer la Santa Misa por los fieles difuntos es una de las mayores obras de caridad que un católico puede realizar. Desde los primeros tiempos de la Iglesia, los cristianos han orado por los difuntos y los han encomendado a la misericordia de Dios.

El Santo Sacrificio de la Misa: Ayuda a las almas del Purgatorio mediante los méritos infinitos de Cristo. Expresa nuestro amor y recuerdo perdurables por quienes nos han precedido en la fe. Se convierte en una poderosa súplica por la misericordia de Dios y el descanso eterno. Refleja nuestra esperanza en la resurrección y en la promesa de la vida eterna. Ninguna oración beneficia más a los fieles difuntos que la Santa Misa.

¿Por qué es tan poderosa la Misa?

La Misa es mucho más que un servicio de oración o una reunión religiosa. Es: La representación sacramental del único sacrificio de Cristo en el Calvario. La ofrenda perfecta de Jesucristo, quien es al mismo tiempo Sacerdote y Víctima. La fuente de la cual brotan abundantes gracias para la Iglesia y el mundo. El acto supremo de adoración que da perfecta gloria a Dios.

Porque la Misa es el propio sacrificio de Cristo ofrecido al Padre, no existe sobre la tierra una oración más grande ni más agradable a Dios.

Mandar celebrar una Misa por un ser querido, un familiar difunto o una intención especial es una profunda expresión de fe, esperanza y caridad. Por medio del Santo Sacrificio de la Misa, presentamos con confianza nuestras necesidades a Dios, poniendo nuestra confianza en su misericordia, su sabiduría y su divina providencia. El mayor regalo que podemos ofrecer a otra persona no son solamente nuestras oraciones, sino a Cristo mismo, verdaderamente presente en la Sagrada Eucaristía y ofrecido sobre el altar para la salvación del mundo.

La corresponsabilidad en acción: Cuidando el hogar de nuestra parroquia

Como fieles administradores de los dones que Dios nos ha confiado, seguimos comprometidos con el cuidado y la conservación de nuestro campus parroquial para que continúe siendo un lugar acogedor, seguro y hermoso para la adoración, el ministerio y la convivencia fraterna. Durante los primeros seis meses de este año y en los meses venideros, hemos estado realizando y continuaremos llevando a cabo diversos proyectos importantes de mantenimiento, reparación y mejoras de capital que son necesarios para proteger nuestras instalaciones y preparar el futuro de la Parroquia Santa Catalina de Alejandría. Aunque muchos de estos proyectos se realizan tras bambalinas, son esenciales para la vida diaria y la sostenibilidad a largo plazo de nuestra parroquia.

Entre los proyectos que ya se han completado, que actualmente se están planificando o que están en marcha, se encuentran la remoción de árboles peligrosos alrededor de nuestro campus (\$7,000–\$9,000); la reparación del dispositivo de prevención de reflujo en la línea principal de agua de RCWD que abastece el sistema de rociadores contra incendios del edificio de la iglesia (\$3,000–\$20,000); el Proyecto del Patio del Claustro (Courtyard Patio Project) (\$101,825); la ingeniería y construcción de la nueva salida de la iglesia (aproximadamente \$500,000); los estudios e informes geotécnicos (\$7,000); los servicios mensuales de ingeniería con Temecula Engineering Consultants, Inc. (\$3,000–\$6,000); las mejoras al sistema de iluminación del campus (\$1,200); la restauración del sistema de monitoreo de los paneles solares (\$1,800); las mejoras a los sistemas de sonido interior y exterior de la iglesia (\$5,000); la actualización del servidor de la oficina parroquial (\$10,000); y la actualización de las computadoras y demás equipos de la oficina (\$5,000).

Estamos profundamente agradecidos por la continua generosidad de nuestra familia parroquial, cuya fiel corresponsabilidad hace posibles estos proyectos. Cada contribución—ya sea mediante su ofrenda semanal, donativos especiales o sus oraciones—nos ayuda a cuidar la parroquia que se nos ha confiado para las futuras generaciones. Gracias por su constante apoyo, por su sacrificio y por su compromiso con la misión de la Parroquia Santa Catalina de Alejandría. 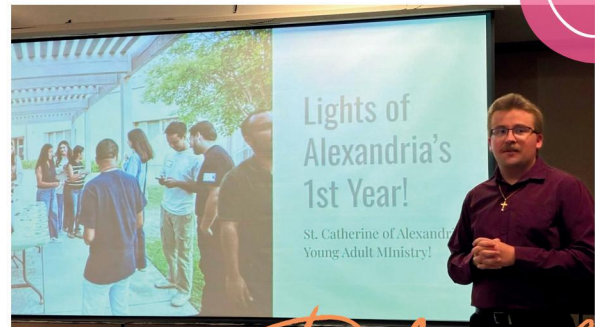
Stewardship in Action: Caring for Our Parish Home

As faithful stewards of the gifts God has entrusted to us, we remain committed to caring for and preserving our parish campus so that it continues to be a welcoming, safe, and beautiful place for worship, ministry, and fellowship. Over the course of the first six months of this year and throughout the coming months, we have been and will continue to address a number of important maintenance, repair, and capital improvement projects that are necessary to protect our facilities and prepare for the future of St. Catherine of Alexandria Parish. While many of these projects take place behind the scenes, they are essential to the daily life and long-term sustainability of our parish.

Among the projects that have been completed, currently being planned, or are underway are the removal of hazardous trees around our campus (\$7,000–\$9,000); the repair of the backflow device on the main RCWD water line that supplies the fire sprinkler system in the church building (\$3,000–\$20,000); the Courtyard Patio Project (\$101,825); engineering and construction of the new church exit (around \$500,000); geotechnical testing and reporting (\$7,000); monthly engineering services with Temecula Engineering Consultants, Inc. (\$3,000–\$6,000); improvements to our campus lighting system (\$1,200); restoration of the solar panel monitoring system (\$1,800); upgrades to both the exterior and interior church speaker systems (\$5,000); upgrades to our office server (\$10,000); and upgrades of our office computers and equipment (\$5,000).

We are deeply grateful for the continued generosity of our parish family, whose faithful stewardship makes these projects possible. Every contribution—whether through your weekly offertory, special gifts, or prayers—helps us care for the parish that has been entrusted to us for future generations. Thank you for your continued support, your sacrifice, and your commitment to the mission of St. Catherine of Alexandria Parish. May God abundantly bless you for your generosity and faithful stewardship.

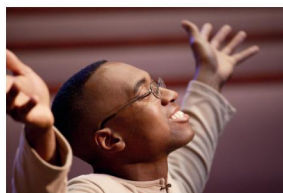

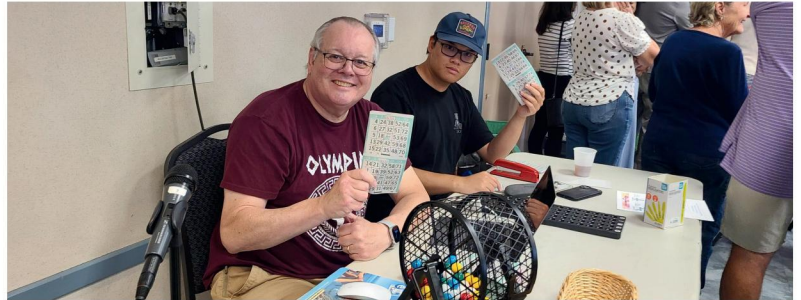

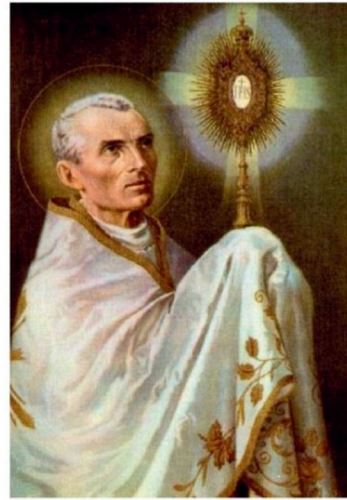

Saint of the Week

SAINT PETER JULIAN EYMUND

- Ordained a Catholic priest in 1834 and devoted his ministry to fostering love for the Holy Eucharist.
- Also co-founded the Servants of the Blessed Sacrament, a religious community for women dedicated to Eucharistic worship.
- Believed the Eucharist was the source of Christian unity, strength, and holiness.
- Known as the "Apostle of the Eucharist" because of his lifelong mission to spread devotion to the Blessed Sacrament.
- Canonized by Pope John XXIII in 1962.
- Feast Day: August 2
- Patron Saint of: Eucharistic adoration, the Blessed Sacrament, and those promoting Eucharistic devotion.

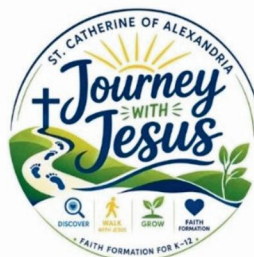

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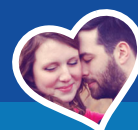
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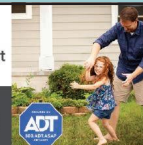
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
