Words from our Shepherd

How are the readings selected?

In Sunday Mass, there are three readings: the first reading is from the Old Testament (except for Easter, because from Easter Sunday until Pentecost Sunday, we hear the reading of the book of Acts). The second reading is usually a letter from St. Paul or another Apostle. And the third reading is always a passage of the Gospel (the Gospel of Saint Matthew, Saint Mark, Saint Luke, or Saint John).

Old Testament readings tell us about God's work before Christ came to earth. The Gospel recounts Jesus' ministries and teachings. The second reading tells us about the life of the early Christians.

In the Mass during Advent, Lent and Easter Sundays, as well as the solemn holidays (Christmas, the Pentecost, etc.), all three readings are closely related to each other.

On other Sundays, which we call Ordinary Sundays, the first reading is chosen in accordance with the meaning of the Gospel. The purpose is to highlight the relation of the Old and New Testaments, of the history of salvation, of which Christ is the center.

The readings are arranged not in chronological order, but in a theological sense: we first hear the testimony of God's people before the time of Jesus (Old Testament reading); next, the testimony of those who received the revelation of the risen Christ (New Testament reading); and finally, the words of Christ Himself (the Gospel).

In every Sunday Mass we have three readings, which are read again after a three-year cycle called Year A, Year B, Year C. Year A reads the Gospel according to St. Matthew; year B, St. Mark; year C, St. Luke; and the Gospel according to St. John is read every year during Lent and Easter seasons.

The weekday Mass has only two readings: reading I from the Old or New Testament (except the Gospel), reading II is always a passage of the Gospel, distributed as follows: in the weeks of 1-9 Year-round, reading the Gospel according to St. Mark; in weeks 10-21, according to St. Matthew; and in weeks 22-34, according to St. Luke. In other Seasons, the Gospel is chosen according to the special nature of each Season.

During the Ordinary Time, the first reading has a two-year cycle (even and odd years), and the second reading (Gospel) has a one-year cycle. Other Seasons, readings I and II all have a one-year cycle.

Palabras de nuestro Pastor

¿Cómo se seleccionan las lecturas?

En la Misa dominical hay tres lecturas: la primera lectura es del Antiguo Testamento (excepto durante la Pascua, ya que desde el Domingo de Pascua hasta el Domingo de Pentecostés escuchamos lecturas del libro de los Hechos de los Apóstoles). La segunda lectura generalmente es una carta de San Pablo o de otro Apóstol. Y la tercera lectura siempre es un pasaje del Evangelio (el Evangelio según San Mateo, San Marcos, San Lucas o San Juan).

Las lecturas del Antiguo Testamento nos hablan de la obra de Dios antes de la venida de Cristo. El Evangelio narra el ministerio y las enseñanzas de Jesús. La segunda lectura nos habla sobre la vida de los primeros cristianos.

En las Misas durante el Adviento, la Cuaresma y los Domingos de Pascua, así como en las fiestas solemnes (Navidad, Pentecostés, etc.), las tres lecturas están estrechamente relacionadas entre sí.

En los demás domingos, que llamamos Domingos del Tiempo Ordinario, la primera lectura se elige de acuerdo con el sentido del Evangelio. El propósito es resaltar la relación entre el Antiguo y el Nuevo Testamento, dentro de la historia de la salvación, cuyo centro es Cristo.

Las lecturas no están organizadas en orden cronológico, sino en un sentido teológico: primero escuchamos el testimonio del pueblo de Dios antes del tiempo de Jesús (lectura del Antiguo Testamento); luego, el testimonio de aquellos que recibieron la revelación del Cristo resucitado (lectura del Nuevo Testamento); y finalmente, las palabras del mismo Cristo (el Evangelio).

En cada Misa dominical, tenemos tres lecturas, las cuales se repiten cada tres años en un ciclo llamado Año A, Año B y Año C. En el Año A se lee el Evangelio según San Mateo; en el Año B, San Marcos; en el Año C, San Lucas; y el Evangelio según San Juan se lee cada año durante la Cuaresma y el tiempo de Pascua.

En la Misa diaria (entre semana) hay solo dos lecturas: la primera (Lectura I) es del Antiguo o Nuevo Testamento (excepto el Evangelio), y la segunda (Lectura II) siempre es un pasaje del Evangelio, distribuido de la siguiente manera: en las semanas 1 a 9 del Tiempo Ordinario se lee el Evangelio según San Marcos; en las semanas 10 a 21, según San Mateo; y en las semanas 22 a 34, según San Lucas. En los demás tiempos litúrgicos, el Evangelio se elige según la naturaleza particular de cada tiempo.

Durante el Tiempo Ordinario, la primera lectura sigue un ciclo de dos años (años pares e impares), y la segunda lectura (el Evangelio) sigue un ciclo de un año. En los otros tiempos litúrgicos, las lecturas I y II siguen un ciclo de un año.

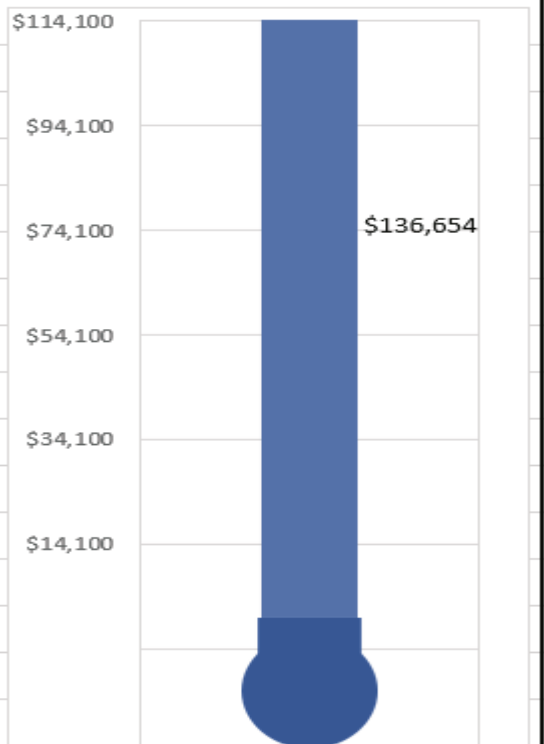

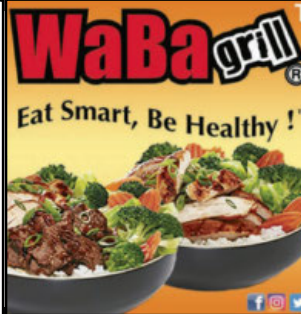
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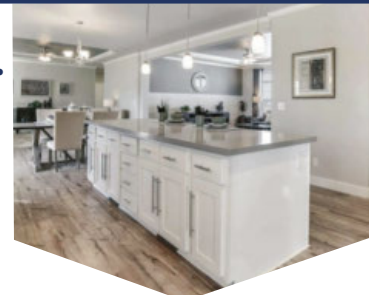
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
