MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

21 de septiembre de 2025

XXV Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Astuto el administrador de la parábola que Jesús nos cuenta hoy. Nos dice que consiguió hacer amigos entre los deudores de su amo, porque les perdonó parte de su deuda. Es elogiado por ser tan ágil en bienes ajenos. "El patrón admiró la manera tan inteligente de actuar de ese administrador que lo estafaba" (Lucas 16:8). No se puede explotar a las personas por dinero y decir que se ama a Dios, especialmente en estos tiempos modernos, donde aparentemente todo funciona bien. Sin embargo, se explota mucho a los inmigrantes de cualquier país del mundo. Abunda la trata de personas, los salarios injustos y las deudas de países pobres imposibles de pagar. Por mencionar algunos ejemplos.

"Existe una astucia cristiana de hacer las cosas con picardía, pero no con el espíritu del mundo: hacer las cosas honestamente. Y esto es bueno. Es lo que dice Jesús cuando invita a ser astutos como serpientes y simples como palomas. Poner juntas estas dos dimensiones es una gracia del Espíritu Santo, una gracia que debemos pedir. También hoy hay muchos de estos estafadores, corruptos... A mí me impresiona ver cómo la corrupción está extendida por todas partes" (Papa Francisco). Tiene razón el Papa Francisco al estar impresionado y a la vez preocupado por tanta deshonestidad en nuestra sociedad. Tenemos que poner acción y darnos cuenta de que no se puede servir a Dios y al dinero. Así lo dijo Jesús, y su mensaje vale tanto entonces como ahora.



GOSPEL MEDITATION September 21, 2025

25th Sunday in Ordinary Time Luke 16:10-13

Before I was a priest, I was a lazy worker for a retail Apple store. Hearing a rumor that my boss was going to fire me, I secretly sold iPhones for half-price, gave away dozens of free iPads, and donated several brand-new laptops to managers in other stores in the mall. After a week, my boss called me into his office. He knew what I was up to. He said I had cost the store thousands of dollars. "Really great work, John," he said. "I am going to recommend you to be my assistant manager and double your pay." I was amazed.

And so are you. Which is understandable because it never happened. How could it? My tall tale is a retelling of Jesus' brow-furrowing parable we hear this week. A lazy, dishonest steward defrauds his boss and then the "master commended the dishonest servant for acting prudently" (Luke 16:8). What is the Lord saying to us?

Most of us treat our spiritual lives like a lazy teenager at an Apple store. We really don't care. We go through the motions. Then, if we are lucky, something happens that shakes us to spiritual action; to employ whatever time, money, and resources we have to build around us a strong network of love. Every saint did that. Our Lord is so good he wants us to use his stuff to forgive debts and to bless others. He wants us to ensure our future. So do it!

St. Pius of Pietrelcina FEAST DAY| September 23



Best known as Padre Pio, St. Pius was born Francesco Forgione in 1887 in Pietrelcina, Italy. As a young boy he suffered many illnesses including typhoid. He joined Capuchin Franciscans at 15 and took the name of Pius or "Pio" in honor of Pope Pius I. He was ordained in 1910, and at this time he received the marks of stigmata, the wounds of Christ, but they eventually healed. Frequent illnesses continued to plague him as a young man.

Padre Pio served in the Italian Medical Corps during World War I, but he was discharged early because of illness, which was likely tuberculosis. He was assigned to the friary in San Giovanni Rotondo. In 1918, while continuing to serve at the friary, the stigmata appeared again, and this time remained until his death.

Many faithful came to see him at the friary, his days were long, beginning with Mass at 5 a.m. then hearing confessions all day with breaks to bless the sick. A simple man, content to do God's will on earth and with the ardent desire to serve the sick and poor in whom he saw Christ, he urged a hospital, Casa Sollievo della Sofferenza (House for the Relief of Suffering), to be built in San Giovanni Rotondo. It opened in 1956.

Padre Pio died at the age of eighty-one in 1968 and in 2002 Pope John Paul II proclaimed him "St. Pio of Pietrelcina."

San Pío de Pietrelcina FIESTA | 23 de septiembre



Conocido popularmente como el Padre Pío, San Pío nació como Francesco Forgione en 1887 en Pietrelcina, Italia. Desde niño sufrió muchas enfermedades, incluida la fiebre tifoidea. A los 15 años ingresó a los Franciscanos Capuchinos y tomó el nombre de Pío en honor al Papa Pío I. Fue ordenado sacerdote en 1910 y, en ese tiempo, recibió las marcas de los estigmas, las llagas de Cristo, aunque al principio se curaron. Las enfermedades frecuentes siguieron afectándolo en su juventud. El Padre Pío sirvió en el Cuerpo Médico del ejército italiano durante la Primera Guerra Mundial, pero fue dado de baja tempranamente por enfermedad, probablemente tuberculosis. Fue destinado al convento de San Giovanni Rotondo. En 1918, mientras continuaba sirviendo en el convento, los estigmas reaparecieron y, esta vez, permanecieron hasta su muerte.

Muchos fieles acudían a verlo al convento. Sus jornadas eran largas: comenzaban con la misa a las 5 a.m. y continuaban con horas de confesiones, interrumpidas solo para bendecir a los enfermos. Hombre sencillo, contento de cumplir la voluntad de Dios en la tierra y con un ardiente deseo de servir a los pobres y enfermos en quienes veía a Cristo, promovió la construcción de un hospital, la Casa Sollievo della Sofferenza (Casa para el Alivio del Sufrimiento), en San Giovanni Rotondo. Este fue inaugurado en 1956.

El Padre Pío murió a los ochenta y un años en 1968 y en 2002 el Papa Juan Pablo II lo proclamó "San Pío de Pietrelcina."

Appeals for hope

16. Echoing the age-old message of the prophets, the Jubilee reminds us that the goods of the earth are not destined for a privileged few, but for everyone. The rich must be generous and not avert their eyes from the faces of their brothers and sisters in need. Here I think especially of those who lack water and food: hunger is a scandal, an open wound on the body of our humanity, and it summons all of us to a serious examination of conscience. I renew my appeal that "with the money spent on weapons and other military expenditures, let us establish a global fund that can finally put an end to hunger and favour development in the most impoverished countries, so that their citizens will not resort to violent or illusory situations, or have to leave their countries in order to seek a more dignified life". Llamamientos a la esperanza

16. Haciendo eco a la palabra antigua de los profetas, el Jubileo nos recuerda que los bienes de la tierra no están destinados a unos pocos privilegiados, sino a todos. 

Saint Carlo Acutis




- **Patronage:** Youth, computer programmers, and those seeking a deeper relationship with the Eucharist
