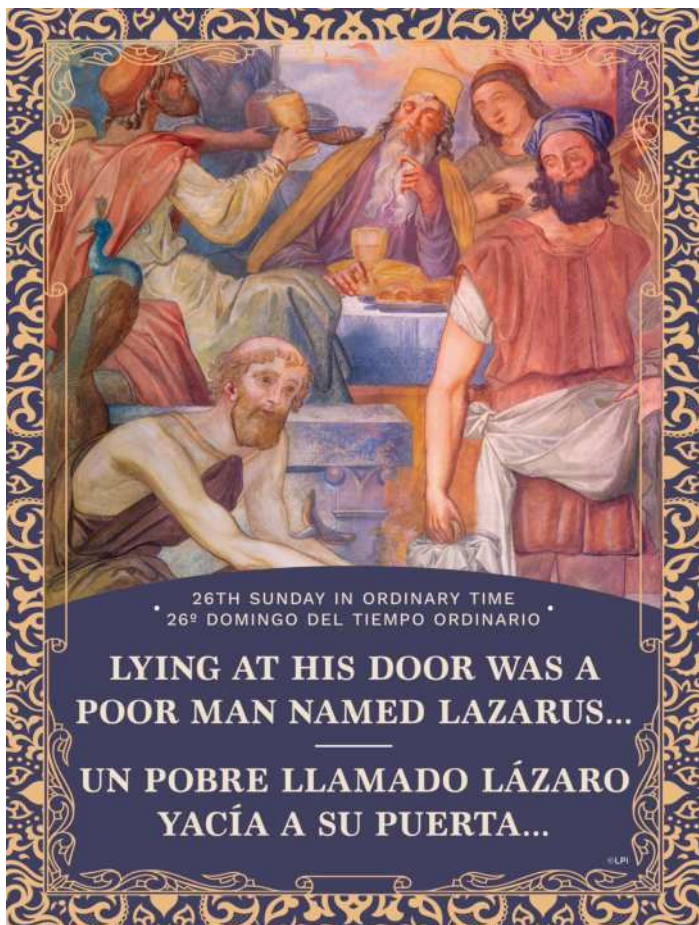

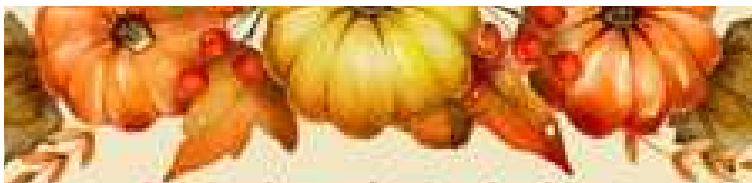

GOSPEL MEDITATION
September 28, 2025
26th Sunday in Ordinary Time Luke 16:19-31

I am embarrassed to admit that I frequently find myself dining and socializing with people who have millions and sometimes billions of dollars. I've eaten more caviar, lobster and wagyu steak than most people on the planet. I justify it by saying it's part of my job. But I have seven pairs of nice jeans and expensive shoes.

So it is rather uncomfortable to hear Our Lord say: "My child, remember that you received what was good in your lifetime, while Lazarus likewise received what was bad; but now he is comforted here, whereas you are tormented" (Luke 16:25). Fellow rich people (and if you're American, you're rich), do we not vehemently though quietly object to this parable's karma-esque reward system? Why bless the rich man just to curse him later? And curse Lazarus just to bless him later? So Americans go to hell, while Burundians and Afghans go to heaven? What is going on?

One clue is that the condemned rich man doesn't complain of injustice. Rather, he simply begs to help his brothers to repent. Of what? We don't know exactly. Perhaps another clue is that the rich man now seems more like the downtrodden Lazarus. He knows what it is to be hungry and thirsty, to be wounded in the gutter; that he deserved that, not fancy meals and clothes. Maybe the rich man finally understands how to receive true blessings, but it is too late for him. But not for me. Not for us.

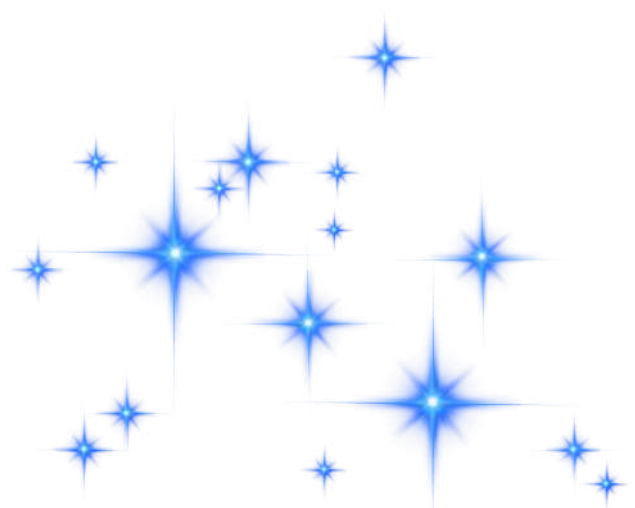


MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO –
28 de septiembre de 2025
XXVI Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario



Un abismo enorme sigue existiendo entre la línea del pobre y del rico, entre los Lázaros y los ricos de nuestro tiempo. ¿Quiénes son? ¿Dónde están? Están mezclados, porque existen ricos tan pobres que no los conocemos; ellos, de su riqueza, comparten sus bienes calladamente con quienes los necesitan. Y podemos encontrar pobres tan ricos por su modo de vivir egoístamente y por almacenar rencor en su corazón. "Además, entre ustedes y nosotros hay un abismo tremendo, de tal manera que los que quieran cruzar desde aquí hasta ustedes no pueden hacerlo, y tampoco lo pueden hacer del lado de ustedes al nuestro" (Lucas 16:26). Aquí se trata de interiorizar la Palabra de Dios y darnos cuenta de que estamos representados en los dos personajes. Y lo importante es ayudar a la gente en sus diferentes necesidades, no hacernos sordos, como si no ocurriera nada.

San Agustín, en su Sermón 33 sobre el Antiguo Testamento, dice lo siguiente: "Escucha el evangelio, mira y examina los pensamientos de los dos hombres de la parábola: Había un hombre rico que se vestía de púrpura y lino y banqueteaba espléndidamente cada día... En cambio, un mendigo llamado Lázaro yacía a la entrada de su casa. No mencionó el nombre del rico, pero sí dijo el nombre del pobre. Dios calló el nombre del que andaba en boca de todos, mientras que mencionó el nombre del que todos callaban". ¿Crees que Dios

Continuation from #16

Another heartfelt appeal that I would make in light of the coming Jubilee is directed to the more affluent nations. I ask that they acknowledge the gravity of so many of their past decisions and determine to forgive the debts of countries that will never be able to repay them. More than a question of generosity, this is a matter of justice. It is made all the more serious today by a new form of injustice which we increasingly recognize, namely, that “a true ‘ecological debt’ exists, particularly between the global North and South, connected to commercial imbalances with effects on the environment and the disproportionate use of natural resources by certain countries over long periods of time”. [9] As sacred Scripture teaches, the earth is the Lord’s and all of us dwell in it as “aliens and tenants” (Lev 25:23). If we really wish to prepare a path to peace in our world, let us commit ourselves to remedying the remote causes of injustice, settling unjust and unpayable debts, and feeding the hungry.

Antes que tratarse de magnanimidad es una cuestión de justicia, agravada hoy por una nueva forma de iniquidad de la que hemos tomado conciencia: «Porque hay una verdadera “deuda ecológica”, particularmente entre el Norte y el Sur, relacionada con desequilibrios comerciales con consecuencias en el ámbito ecológico, así como con el uso desproporcionado de los recursos naturales llevado a cabo históricamente por algunos países». [9] Como enseña la Sagrada Escritura, la tierra pertenece a Dios y todos nosotros habitamos en ella como «extranjeros y huéspedes» (Lv 25,23). Si verdaderamente queremos preparar en el mundo el camino de la paz, esforcémonos por remediar las causas que originan las injusticias, cancelemos las deudas injustas e insolutas y saciemos a los hambrientos.

SAINT OF THE WEEK

Saint Vincent de Paul

Feast Day: September 27

Patronage: Charitable societies, hospitals, and the poor

Life: Born in 1581 in Pouy, France; grew up in a humble family. Initially pursued a career in the priesthood.

Conversion: After being captured by pirates and enslaved for two years, Vincent had a deeper encounter with God that led him to dedicate his life to serving the poor and marginalized.

Founder: Founded the Congregation of the Mission (Vincentians) and co-founded the Daughters of Charity with St. Louise de Marillac in 1633, dedicated to caring for the poor, sick, and orphaned.

Legacy: Known for his tireless work with the poor and for organizing charitable efforts across France. He is often called the "Apostle of Charity" for his work in founding organizations that still help the poor today.

Inspiration: A model of humility, selflessness, and deep devotion to God through serving others. He showed that sanctity can be found in humble service, especially to the most vulnerable.



WHY register?

By registering in a parish, you show your desire to be a part of our Catholic faith community. Registering is important. Census numbers (numbers of registered parishioners) help determine the number and kind of Masses and programs, the number of priests, obligations to the Diocese, and so on.

This time of year, we are getting many requests for a signature from our Pastor on a form in order for you to be a godparent for someone else's child or a sponsor for someone who is being confirmed. In order for us to be diligent in signing these forms, we need to check our records as to your attendance. Also, being registered and active is necessary to receive a discounted fee for Faith Formation or for weddings.

THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT: because our parish is so large, the only way for us to verify that you are attending Mass and an active member is for you to turn in your envelope with your parish registration number on it. It can be empty, \$1.00 or \$1,000,000—we just need to know that you are joining us.

What does committing to a parish mean? Committing to a parish is much like a commitment to family, friend, school, or community group. The parish makes a commitment to be there for the parish family: to provide Masses, Sacraments, educational programs and ministries. When you join a parish, you make a commitment to be an active member, to contribution of your time, talent, treasure, and prayer to support the mission and work of the Church.
