OCTOBER IS THE MONTH OF THE HOLY ROSARY

In the Catholic Church, each of the 12 months of the year has a devotional theme. It's a great way to bring special traditions, symbols, colors, and even foods into our faith life at home.

October is the month of the Holy Rosary. This is primarily due to the fact that the liturgical feast of Our Lady of the Rosary is celebrated annually on October 7. It was instituted to honor the Blessed Virgin Mary in gratitude for the protection that she gives the Church in answer to the praying of the Rosary by the faithful.

The decision to designate October as the month of the Rosary stems from the Church's desire to extend its thanksgiving to Our Lady for victory in the Battle of Lepanto and in addition, when Our Lady appeared in Fatima in May 1917, she identified herself as Our Lady of the Rosary.

We can ask our Blessed Mother for prayers just as we ask family and friends to pray for us. Mary loves us and she loves her son Jesus. She wants everyone to know and love Him, too. She comes to our aid as our mother to help us and to point the way to her Son. Remember what she told the servers at the wedding feast at Cana? "Do whatever He tells you." (John 2:5)

She is also the Queen of Heaven and earth, crowned by her son as the Queen mother. (This was a common practice of the Jews in Old Testament times. The queen mother would help her son rule, not the king's wife.)

Mary is close to God as his daughter. He allows her to give out His graces to each of us. This shows how important she is to God as well - and she has the authority from God to give out His grace to us. As a mother would not deny her child, Mother Mary would not deny us - we only need to ask her for God's grace and she will give it to us.

That's why it is so important for us to give our attention to the upcoming vote on Proposition 1. It is an extreme change to our state constitution and with the intercession of the Blessed Mother, we can defeat it and save unborn lives. Join us in praying for the Blessed Mother's intercession. This proposition on the November 8 general election ballot would enshrine abortion in the California state constitution and remove all abortion restrictions, even for late-term

VOTE "NO" ON PROPOSITION 1

Proposition 1 is a worst-case scenario for abortion in California. It is an expensive and misleading ballot measure that allows unlimited late-term abortions – for any reason, at any time, even moments before birth, paid for by tax dollars.

Prop 1 isn't needed. Sadly, California already has some of the most permissive abortion laws in the nation that would remain in effect without the amendment, including our current limit on late-term abortions that are permitted only for the life and health of the mother. Prop 1 destroys this common-sense limit.

California does not limit state spending on abortion, and with thousands more traveling from other states, the cost will be in the hundreds of millions. Don't hand lawmakers a blank check to pay for abortions, and don't let them make California an "abortion sanctuary."

La Proposición 1 es el peor de los casos para el aborto en California. Es una medida electoral costosa y engañosa que permite abortos tardíos sin límites – por cualquier motivo, en cualquier momento, incluso momentos antes del nacimiento – a expensas de los contribuyentes.

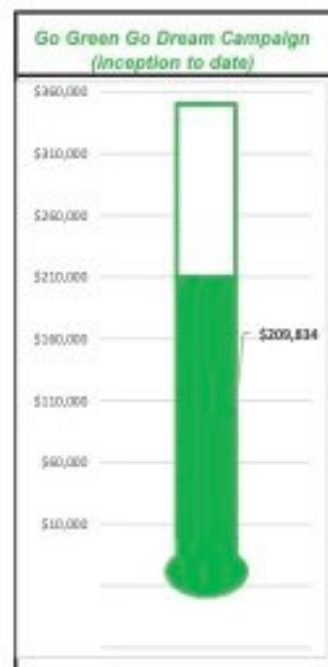
