

Historia de Carlo Acutis, siervo de Dios

"El hecho de que estuviéramos vivos al mismo tiempo y tengamos una edad tan cercana parece resaltar aún más la brecha entre nuestros 'niveles' de santidad", dijo Taylor Hyatt, un canadiense de 28 años. Nació el mismo año que Acutis. a CNA

"Dicho esto, realmente aprecio su profundo amor por la Eucaristía y su interés en Internet. Compartimos esos intereses, cuando yo tenía su edad y hasta ahora", dijo. Hyatt también admiró el interés de Acutis en los derechos de las personas con discapacidad, una causa en la que también está involucrada.

P. Paul, un sacerdote recientemente ordenado en Ontario, fue más directo en su evaluación de su vida con Acutis.

"Para mí, personalmente, saber lo santo que era el Beato Carlo me hace sentir como una mierda", dijo. "Nací el mismo año que él y cuando era adolescente no era particularmente santo".

"Pero hablé de él con nuestro grupo de adultos jóvenes la semana pasada y les mostré la foto de su tumba y más de unas pocas personas comentaron sobre el hecho de que vestía ropa normal, que jugaba videojuegos y era bueno con las computadoras," Dijo el P. Pablo.

"He tratado de usar a Pier Giorgio como un ejemplo con el que los jóvenes pueden identificarse, pero quizás el Beato Carlo podría ser mejor en estos días dado lo contemporáneo que es".

Es la "normalidad" de Acutis lo que lo hace tan interesante, dijeron algunos católicos a CNA.

"The fact that we were alive at the same time and are so close in age seems to highlight even more the gap between our 'levels' of holiness," Taylor Hyatt, a 28-year-old from Canada, told CNA. She was born the same year as Acutis.

"That said, I really appreciate his deep love for the Eucharist and interest in the Internet. We shared those interests, back when I was his age and up to now," she said. Hyatt also admired Acutis' interest in disability rights, a cause she is also involved with.

Fr. Paul, a recently-ordained priest in Ontario, was more blunt in his assessment of his life to Acutis'.

"For me personally, knowing how holy Blessed Carlo was makes me feel like a piece of crap," he said. "I was born the same year as him and as a teenager wasn't particularly saintly."

"But I talked about him to our young adults group last week and showed them the picture of his tomb and more than a few people commented on the fact that he was wearing normal clothes, and that he played video games and was good with computers," said Fr. Paul.

"I have tried to use Pier Giorgio as an example young people can relate to but perhaps Blessed Carlo might be better these days given how contemporary he is."

It is Acutis' "normalcy" that makes him so interesting, some Catholics told CNA.

Acutis "is someone we can look at and quite literally picture ourselves," Alex Trevino, a 30-year-old from Dallas, told CNA. "He's buried in the clothes that I wore as a teenager."




5. Issues of human fraternity and social friendship have always been a concern of mine. In recent years, I have spoken of them repeatedly and in different settings. In this Encyclical, I have sought to bring together many of those statements and to situate them in a broader context of reflection. In the preparation of *Laudato Si'*, I had a source of inspiration in my brother Bartholomew, the Orthodox Patriarch, who has spoken forcefully of our need to care for creation. In this case, I have felt particularly encouraged by the Grand Imam Ahmad Al-Tayyeb, with whom I met in Abu Dhabi, where we declared that "God has created all human beings equal in rights, duties and dignity, and has called them to live together as brothers and sisters".[5] This was no mere diplomatic gesture, but a reflection born of dialogue and common commitment. The present Encyclical takes up and develops some of the great themes raised in the Document that we both signed. I have also incorporated, along with my own thoughts, a number of letters, documents and considerations that I have received from many individuals and groups throughout the world.

5. Las cuestiones relacionadas con la fraternidad y la amistad social han estado siempre entre mis preocupaciones. Durante los últimos años me he referido a ellas reiteradas veces y en diversos lugares. Quise recoger en esta encíclica muchas de esas intervenciones situándolas en un contexto más amplio de reflexión. Además, si en la redacción de la *Laudato si'* tuve una fuente de inspiración en mi hermano Bartolomé, el Patriarca ortodoxo que propuso con mucha fuerza el cuidado de la creación, en este caso me sentí especialmente estimulado por el Gran Imán Ahmad Al-Tayyeb, con quien me encontré en Abu Dhabi para recordar que Dios «ha creado todos los seres humanos iguales en los derechos, en los deberes y en la dignidad, y los ha llamado a convivir como hermanos entre ellos»[5]. No se trató de un mero acto diplomático sino de una reflexión hecha en diálogo y de un compromiso conjunto. Esta encíclica recoge y desarrolla grandes temas planteados en aquel documento que firmamos juntos. También acogí aquí, con mi propio lenguaje, numerosas cartas y documentos con reflexiones que recibí de tantas personas y grupos de todo el mundo.




Pick a saint's name as your Confirmation name. This option symbolizes a new beginning or renewed dedication in your faith and a connection with a particular saint. Your commitment would be symbolized with the taking of a new name to show that you are in some ways now a new person. This new name would be used after your present middle name and before your last name. The saint's name you choose would represent the direction you feel your faith life is taking or would represent a strength or attribute you feel you need. It is important and necessary to learn something about the saint you choose before you decide on that name. (The option of taking a new name is not to be used because you like the sound of the name, how it fits with your other names, or only because it is the name of a nice friend or relative.)





