# Advent



## DECEMBER 7

SENT TO PROCLAIM: BIBLICAL PASSAGE: LUKE 9:1-6 (NAB)

He summoned the Twelve and gave them power and authority over all demons and to cure diseases, and he sent them to proclaim the kingdom of God and to heal [the sick]. He said to them, "Take nothing for the journey, neither walking stick, nor sack, nor food, nor money, and let no one take a second tunic. Whatever house you enter, stay there and leave from there. And as for those who do not welcome you, when you leave that town, shake the dust from your feet in testimony against them." Then they set out and went from village to village proclaiming the good news and curing diseases everywhere.

### REFLECTION

Jesus sends the twelve with power and authority to proclaim the kingdom of God. In Advent, we, too, are sent as messengers of this kingdom, sharing the good news of Christ's coming. Our mission is to bring healing, hope, and the message of salvation to a world in need.

### PRAYER

Empower us, O God, to proclaim your kingdom with boldness and love. Amen.

### THOUGHT FOR THE DAY

We are called and sent to be bearers of God's kingdom.

## DECEMBER 8

PREPARING THE WAY: BIBLICAL PASSAGE: LUKE 3:1-6 (NAB)

In the fifteenth year of the reign of Tiberius Caesar, when Pontius Pilate was governor of Judea, and Herod was tetrarch of Galilee, and his brother Philip tetrarch of the region of Ituraea and Trachonitis, and Lysanias was tetrarch of Abilene, during the high priesthood of Annas and Caiaphas, the word of God came to John the son of Zechariah in the desert. He went throughout [the] whole region of the Jordan, proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins, as it is written in the book of the words of the prophet Isaiah: "A voice of one crying out in the desert: 'Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths. Every valley shall be filled and every mountain and hill shall be made low. The winding roads shall be made straight, and the rough ways made smooth, and all flesh shall see the salvation of God.'"

### REFLECTION

John the Baptist's call to prepare the way of the Lord echoes through the ages, inviting us to make straight paths for Christ's coming. Advent is a time of preparation, where we examine our hearts, repent, and make room for the Savior. The wilderness of our lives is transformed as we welcome the Lord.

### PRAYER

Prepare our hearts, O God, to receive your Son with joy and expectation. Amen.

### THOUGHT FOR THE DAY

Preparing the way for Christ to transform our lives.

## DECEMBER 9

COMFORT MY PEOPLE: BIBLICAL PASSAGE: ISAIAH 40:1-11 (NAB)

Comfort, give comfort to my people, says your God. Speak to the heart of Jerusalem, and proclaim to her that her service has ended, that her guilt is expiated, That she has received from the hand of the LORD double for all her sins. A voice proclaims: In the wilderness prepare the way of the LORD! Make straight in the wasteland a highway for our God! Every valley shall be lifted up, every mountain and hill made low; The rugged land shall be a plain, the rough country, a broad valley. Then the glory of the LORD shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together; for the mouth of the LORD has spoken. A voice says, "Proclaim!" I answer, "What shall I proclaim?" "All flesh is grass, and all their loyalty like the flower of the field. The grass withers, the flower wilts, when the breath of the LORD blows upon it." "Yes, the people is grass! The grass withers, the flower wilts, but the word of our God stands forever." Go up onto a high mountain, Zion, herald of good news! Cry out at the top of your voice, Jerusalem, herald of good news! Cry out, do not fear! Say to the cities of Judah: Here is your God! Here comes with power the Lord GOD, who rules by his strong arm; Here is his reward with him, his recompense before him. Like a shepherd he feeds his flock; in his arms he gathers the lambs, Carrying them in his bosom, leading the ewes with care.

### REFLECTION

The prophet Isaiah brings comfort and hope to a weary people. Advent is a season where we, too, hear God's words of comfort, assuring us of God's presence and care. As we await Christ's coming, we are called to be agents of comfort and hope in our world.

### PRAYER

Comfort us, O God, and make us instruments of your peace. Amen.

### THOUGHT FOR THE DAY

God's comfort sustains us as we wait for Christ's coming.

## DECEMBER 10

### A SIGN OF UNITY: BIBLICAL PASSAGE: ISAIAH 19:18-25 (NAB)

On that day there shall be five cities in the land of Egypt that speak the language of Canaan and swear by the LORD of hosts; one shall be called "City of the Sun." On that day there shall be an altar to the LORD at the center of Egypt, and a sacred pillar to the LORD near its boundary. This will be a sign and witness to the LORD of hosts in the land of Egypt, so that when they cry out to the LORD because of their oppressors, he will send them a savior to defend and deliver them. The LORD shall make himself known to Egypt, and the Egyptians shall know the LORD in that day; they shall offer sacrifices and oblations, make vows to the LORD and fulfill them. Although the LORD shall smite Egypt severely, he shall heal them; they shall turn to the LORD and he shall be moved by their entreaty and heal them. On that day there shall be a highway from Egypt to Assyria; the Assyrians shall enter Egypt, and the Egyptians enter Assyria, and the Egyptians shall worship with the Assyrians. On that day Israel shall be a third party with Egypt and Assyria, a blessing in the midst of the earth, when the LORD of hosts gives this blessing: "Blessed be my people Egypt, and the work of my hands Assyria, and my heritage, Israel."

### REFLECTION

Isaiah's vision of Egypt and Assyria worshipping alongside Israel powerfully represents unity in God's kingdom. In Advent, we long for the day when all nations will unite in worship, united by Christ. This vision challenges us to work for peace and reconciliation, preparing for the day of Christ's reign.

### PRAYER

Unite us, O God, in your love as we await the coming of your kingdom. Amen.

### THOUGHT FOR THE DAY

God's kingdom is a place of unity and peace for all people.

## DECEMBER 11

### STRENGTHEN THE WEAK: BIBLICAL PASSAGE: ISAIAH 35:3-7 (NAB)

Strengthen hands that are feeble, make firm knees that are weak, Say to the fearful of heart: Be strong, do not fear! Here is your God, he comes with vindication; With divine recompense he comes to save you. Then the eyes of the blind shall see, and the ears of the deaf be opened; Then the lame shall leap like a stag, and the mute tongue sing for joy. For waters will burst forth in the wilderness, and streams in the Arabah. The burning sands will become pools, and the thirsty ground, springs of water; The abode where jackals crouch will be a marsh for the reed and papyrus.

### REFLECTION

Isaiah's prophecy speaks of strengthening the weak and fearful, promising a time of healing and restoration. Advent reminds us that Christ comes to bring healing to our broken world. As we prepare for his coming, we are called to be agents of strength and healing, embodying Christ's love to those in need.

### PRAYER

Strengthen our hearts, O God, and make us vessels of your healing grace. Amen.

### THOUGHT FOR THE DAY

Christ's coming brings healing and strength to the weary.

## DECEMBER 12

### JOY IN SALVATION: BIBLICAL PASSAGE: ISAIAH 12:2-6 (NAB)

God indeed is my salvation; I am confident and unafraid. For the LORD is my strength and my might, and he has been my salvation. With joy you will draw water from the fountains of salvation, And you will say on that day: give thanks to the LORD, acclaim his name; Among the nations make known his deeds, proclaim how exalted is his name. Sing praise to the LORD for he has done glorious things; let this be known throughout all the earth.

### REFLECTION

Isaiah's song is one of joy and thanksgiving for the salvation God provides. In Advent, we are invited to rejoice in the salvation that Christ brings, a joy that flows from the wells of God's grace. This season is a time to celebrate the deep and abiding joy that comes from knowing we are loved and saved by God.

### PRAYER

Fill our hearts with joy, O God, as we rejoice in your salvation. Amen.

### THOUGHT FOR THE DAY

The joy of salvation is a gift that sustains us in all seasons.

## DECEMBER 13

### A FAMINE FOR HEARING: BIBLICAL PASSAGE: AMOS 8:4-12 (NAB)

Hear this, you who trample upon the needy and destroy the poor of the land: "When will the new moon be over," you ask, "that we may sell our grain, And the sabbath, that we may open the grain-bins? We will diminish the ephah, add to the shekel, and fix our scales for cheating! We will buy the destitute for silver, and the poor for a pair of sandals; even the worthless grain we will sell!" The LORD has sworn by the pride of Jacob: Never will I forget a thing they have done! Shall not the land tremble because of this, and all who dwell in it mourn? It will all rise up and toss like the Nile, and subside like the river of Egypt. On that day—oracle of the Lord GOD— I will make the sun set at midday and in broad daylight cover the land with darkness. I will turn your feasts into mourning and all your songs into dirges. I will cover the loins of all with sackcloth and make every head bald. I will make it like the time of mourning for an only child, and its outcome like a day of bitter weeping. See, days are coming —oracle of the Lord GOD— when I will send a famine upon the land: Not a hunger for bread, or a thirst for water, but for hearing the word of the LORD. They shall stagger from sea to sea and wander from north to east In search of the word of the LORD, but they shall not find it.

### REFLECTION

The prophet Amos warns of a time when there will be a famine, not of bread, but of hearing the words of the Lord. Advent challenges us to be attentive to God's word, to listen deeply, and to act on what we hear. In a world filled with noise, we are called to make space for God's voice, allowing it to guide and sustain us.

### PRAYER

Open our ears, O God, to hear your word and respond in faith. Amen.

### THOUGHT FOR THE DAY

Listening to God's word is essential to living a faithful life.

## 7 de diciembre: Enviados a Proclamar

PASAJE BÍBLICO: LUCAS 9:1-6 (DHH)

Jesús reunió a sus doce discípulos, y les dio poder y autoridad para expulsar toda clase de demonios y para curar enfermedades. Los envió a anunciar el reino de Dios y a sanar a los enfermos. Les dijo: --No lleven nada para el camino: ni bastón, ni bolsa, ni pan, ni dinero, ni ropa de repuesto. En cualquier casa donde lleguen, quédense hasta que se vayan del lugar. Y si en algún pueblo no los quieren recibir, salgan de él y sacúdanse el polvo de los pies, para que les sirva a ellos de advertencia. Salieron ellos, pues, y fueron por todas las aldeas, anunciando la buena noticia y sanando enfermos.

### REFLEXIÓN

Jesús envía a los doce con poder y autoridad para proclamar el reino de Dios. En Adviento, también somos enviados como mensajeros de este reino, compartiendo la buena nueva de la venida de Cristo. Nuestra misión es llevar sanación, esperanza y el mensaje de salvación a un mundo necesitado.

## 8 de diciembre: Preparando el Camino

PASAJE BÍBLICO: LUCAS 3:1-6 (DHH)

Era el año quince del gobierno del emperador Tiberio, y Poncio Pilato era gobernador de Judea. Herodes gobernaba en Galilea, su hermano Filipo gobernaba en Iturea y Traconítide, y Lisaniás gobernaba en Abilene. Anás y Caifás eran los sumos sacerdotes. Por aquel tiempo, Dios habló en el desierto a Juan, el hijo de Zacarías, y Juan pasó por todos los lugares junto al río Jordán, diciendo a la gente que ellos debían volverse a Dios y ser bautizados, para que Dios les perdonara sus pecados. Esto sucedió como está escrito en el libro del profeta Isaías: «Una voz grita en el desierto: «Preparen el camino del Señor; ábranle un camino recto. Todo valle será rellenado, todo cerro y colina será nivelado, los caminos torcidos serán enderezados, y allanados los caminos disparejos. Todo el mundo verá la salvación que Dios envía.»

### REFLEXIÓN

El llamado de Juan el Bautista a preparar el camino del Señor resuena a través de los siglos, invitándonos a allanar los caminos para la venida de Cristo. El Adviento es un tiempo de preparación, donde examinamos nuestros corazones, nos arrepentimos y hacemos espacio para el Salvador. El desierto de nuestras vidas se transforma al dar la bienvenida al Señor.

Prepara nuestros corazones, Oh Dios, para recibir a tu Hijo con alegría y expectativa. Amén.

## 9 de diciembre: Consolad a Mi Pueblo

PASAJE BÍBLICO: ISAÍAS 40:1-11 (DHH)

El Dios de ustedes dice: «Consuelen, consuelen a mi pueblo; hablen con cariño a Jerusalén y díganle que su esclavitud ha terminado, que ya ha pagado por sus faltas, que ya ha recibido de mi mano el doble del castigo por todos sus pecados.» Una voz grita: «Preparen al Señor un camino en el desierto, tracen para nuestro Dios una calzada recta en la región estéril. Rellenen todas las cañadas, allanen los cerros y las colinas, conviertan la región quebrada y montañosa en llanura completamente lisa. Entonces mostrará el Señor su gloria, y todos los hombres juntos la verán. El Señor mismo lo ha dicho.» Una voz dice: «Grita», y yo pregunto: «¿Qué debo gritar?» «Que todo hombre es como hierba, itan firme como una flor del campo! La hierba se seca y la flor se marchita cuando el soplo del Señor pasa sobre ellas. Ciertamente la gente es como hierba. La hierba se seca y la flor se marchita, pero la palabra de nuestro Dios permanece firme para siempre.» Súbete, Sión, a la cumbre de un monte, levanta con fuerza tu voz para anunciar una buena noticia. Levanta sin miedo la voz, Jerusalén, y anuncia a las ciudades de Judá: «¡Aquí está el Dios de ustedes!» Llega ya el Señor con poder, sometiéndolo todo con la fuerza de su brazo. Trae a su pueblo después de haberlo rescatado. Viene como un pastor que cuida su rebaño; levanta los corderos en sus brazos, los lleva junto al pecho y atiende con cuidado a las recién paridas.

### REFLEXIÓN

El profeta Isaías trae un mensaje de consuelo y esperanza a un pueblo cansado. El Adviento es una temporada en la que también escuchamos las palabras de consuelo de Dios, asegurándonos de la presencia y el cuidado de Dios. Mientras esperamos la venida de Cristo, estamos llamados a ser agentes de consuelo y esperanza en nuestro mundo.

### ORACIÓN

Consuélanos, Oh Dios, y haznos instrumentos de tu paz. Amén.

### PENSAMIENTO DEL DÍA

El consuelo de Dios nos sostiene mientras esperamos la venida de Cristo.

## 10 de diciembre: Un Signo de Unidad

PASAJE BÍBLICO: ISAÍAS 19:18-25 (DHH)

En ese día habrá en Egipto cinco ciudades que hablarán hebreo y que jurarán fidelidad al Señor todopoderoso. Una de ellas se llamará Ciudad del Sol. En ese día habrá un altar dedicado al Señor en pleno Egipto, y cerca de su frontera se levantará una piedra en honor al Señor. Servirá de señal, para que se recuerde al Señor todopoderoso en el país de Egipto. Cuando griten al Señor pidiendo ayuda contra los que les oprimen, él les enviará un libertador, para que los defienda y los salve. El Señor se dará a conocer a los egipcios, y ellos reconocerán al Señor, le darán culto y le ofrecerán sacrificios y ofrendas. Harán promesas al Señor y las cumplirán. El Señor herirá a Egipto, pero después lo sanará. Ellos se volverán al Señor, y él se compadecerá de ellos y los sanará. En ese día habrá un amplio camino desde Egipto hasta Asiria. Los asirios podrán llegar hasta Egipto y los egipcios hasta Asiria, y los egipcios y los asirios adorarán juntos al Señor. En ese día Israel se colocará a la par con Egipto y Asiria, y será una bendición en medio de la tierra. El Señor todopoderoso los bendecirá, diciendo: «Yo bendigo a Egipto, mi pueblo, a Asiria, obra de mis manos, y a Israel, mi propiedad.»

### REFLEXIÓN

La visión de Isaías de Egipto y Asiria adorando junto a Israel es una imagen poderosa de unidad en el reino de Dios. En Adviento, anhelamos el día en que todas las naciones se unan en adoración, unidas por Cristo. Esta visión nos desafía a trabajar por la paz y la reconciliación, preparándonos para el día del reinado de Cristo.

### ORACIÓN

Únenos, Oh Dios, en tu amor, mientras esperamos la venida de tu reino. Amén.

### PENSAMIENTO DEL DÍA

El reino de Dios es un lugar de unidad y paz para todas las personas.

## 11 de diciembre: Fortalecer al Débil

PASAJE BÍBLICO: ISAÍAS 35:3-7 (DHH)

Fortalezcan a los débiles, den valor a los cansados, digan a los tímidos: «¡Ánimo, no tengan miedo! ¡Aquí está su Dios para salvarlos, y a sus enemigos los castigará como merecen!» Entonces los ciegos verán y los sordos oirán; los lisiados saltarán como venados y los mudos gritarán. En el desierto, tierra seca, brotará el agua a torrentes. El desierto será un lago, la tierra seca se llenará de manantiales. Donde ahora viven los chacales, crecerán cañas y juncos.

### REFLEXIÓN

La profecía de Isaías habla de fortalecer a los débiles y temerosos, prometiendo un tiempo de sanación y restauración. El Adviento nos recuerda que Cristo viene a traer sanación a nuestro mundo roto. 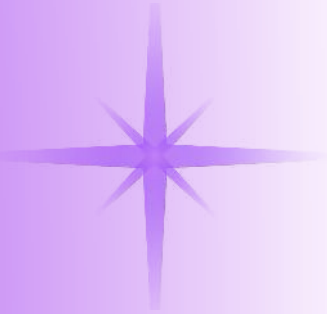
